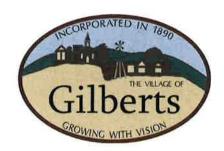

MINUTES FOR VILLAGE OF GILBERTS SPECIAL BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING Village Hall: 87 Galligan Road, Gilberts, IL 60136 Meeting Minutes Wednesday, September 30, 2020

1. CALL TO ORDER / PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

President Zirk called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. He proceeded to lead those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. ROLL CALL / ESTABLISH QUORUM

Deputy Village Clerk Phillip Versten called the roll. Roll call: Members present: Trustees Kojzarek, Zambetti, Farrell, and President Zirk. Members on phone: Trustees Allen, Hacker, Corbett. Others present: Village Administrator Brian Bourdeau. Staff on the phone: Village Attorney Julie Tappendorf.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments at this time.

4. CONSENT AGENDA

- A. A Motion to approve Minutes from the September 15, 2020 Village Board Meeting
- B. A Motion to approve a Request by Cruisin to Allow Live Entertainment as part of its Outdoor Dining use at 11 Galligan Road on October 3, 2020

President Zirk asked if any of the board members had any consent agenda items they wished to remove for separate consideration. After hearing none, asked for a motion to approve.

A Motion was made by Trustee Kojzarek and seconded by Trustee Zambetti to Approve Consent Agenda Items 4A-B as presented. Roll call vote: Trustees Kojzarek, Allen, Zambetti, Farrell, Hacker, and Corbett voted Aye. 0-nays, 0-abstained. Motion carried.

5. ITEMS FOR APPROVAL

A. Ordinance 11-2020, An Ordinance Amending and Replacing in their entirety Ordinance Nos. 06-2020, 07-2020 and 09-2020 Approving a Temporary Policy Authorizing and Regulating Outdoor Dining

The Board discussed the proposed ordinance which is intended to modify provisions in Ordinances 06-2020, 07-2020 and 09-2020 relating to outdoor dining and special events, making them subject to staff review and approval. Item F of the ordinance, as presented, was amended to require live music special event applications to be approved by the Village Administrator.

A motion was made by Trustee Hacker and seconded by Trustee Zambetti to Approve Ordinance 11-2020 Amending and Replacing in their entirety Ordinance Nos. 06-2020, 07-2020 and 09-2020 Approving a Temporary Policy Authorizing and Regulating Outdoor Dining as amended. Roll call vote: Ayes: Trustees Hacker, Kojzarek, Corbett, Zambetti, and Farrell. Nays: Trustee Allen. 0-abstained. Motion carried.

6. STAFF REPORTS

Attorney Tappendorf

• The Illinois Supreme Court denied an appeal filed by WC Media, thereby ending any pending litigation.

Administrator Bourdeau

• In light of the ordinance passed this evening, a pending application that had been received for an outdoor music event at Cruisin on October 31st will be administratively approved, and taken off the October 6 meeting agenda. It will be communicated via the weekly report.

7. TRUSTEE REPORTS

Trustee Kojzarek

• Suggested that Administrator Bourdeau send an email to Trustees, rather than waiting until the weekly report, when administratively approving outdoor music events.

Trustee Farrell

• A commercial web site selling water quality services and equipment had included the Village as one of several on a list of communities not meeting their water quality standards, as part of a marketing campaign. Administrator Bourdeau assured that our water meets all IEPA standards for quality.

8. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

- A notice of the Village's position on Halloween trick or treating consistent with the State's Phase 4 guidelines will be published and distributed at the end of the week.
- The Board wants grading to progress at the Conservancy and so does not want to incur delays by requiring Gilberts Development LLC to come before them at each phase for a resolution approving such grading. We have the option of having him proceed with Administration-level approvals, as long as he agrees to do the work at his own risk. Polling to the Board: are we comfortable with having staff review and approve developer requests to proceed with grading-only work at each individual phase of development, as long as developer understands that the

risk is solely his, and that he submits appropriate hold harmless, waivers, and associated agreements and documentation to staff in a timely manner for review and approval with each request at each phase of a development? The Trustees agreed to allow the process and Attorney Tappendorf will draw up appropriate policy and documents enabling same.

An executive session did not take place.

There being no further public business to discuss, a Motion was made by Trustee Kojzarek and seconded by Trustee Zambetti to adjourn from the public meeting at 8:25 p.m. Voice vote carried unanimously.

One of Public Work's highest priority roles is to remove snow and ice from roadways to ensure safe travel on all Village roads. This task is one of the most visible and essential roles in any public works organization. Therefore, it is essential that the equipment that is used to perform these tasks be invested and maintained at high levels.

It is with this vital role in mind that the Public Works Department would like to utilize Municipal

Impact Fees to purchase a new Ford F-550 One Ton Dump Truck with a Snow Fighter Upfit Package. With the State of Illinois still holding no joint purchasing contract for medium or heavy-duty trucks, Village Staff has turned to alternate purchasing cooperatives to find low pricing. Through the Sourcewell Purchasing Cooperative, the Village is able to utilize two separate joint purchasing contracts to purchase the chassis of the Ford F-550 and the upfitting package.

The need for a new truck with the ability to perform snow removal at a high level is clear with the upcoming addition of the conservancy. With Public Works anticipating a possible acceptance of the first stage of the Conservancy before the 2021/2022 snow season. Placing an order for a truck now will allow us time to receive the chassis, perform the upfitting and troubleshoot any potential problems before the snow season begins.

The addition of a new truck will also open up the possibility of enhancing our capability to utilize different deicing methods such as adding pre-wet systems onto vehicles. This will allow us to lower the amount of bulk rock salt used by 20-30%.

This purchase will also keep our fleet uniform with all Ford Trucks, consistent with the efficiency of having uniform standard parts, which allows for better inventory stocking and the expansion of in-house knowledge of the vehicles, allowing us to perform more maintenance with Village personnel.

This purchase would be made under the direction of Administration with clearance from the Village Board via the approval of the Capital Projects Memo (June 16, 2020), which authorized Village Staff to pursue quotes and pricing to purchase a "New Public Works Truck with Plowing Equipment" utilizing Municipal Impact Fees. Village Staff has reviewed and brought forward pricing and Sourcewell contracts. The utilization of Municipal Impact Fees comes directly from

the impact that the addition of the Conservancy has on our future snow plowing and maintenance programs. The addition of multiple miles of road will require an additional snow route and truck to maintain the roadways during the winter months.

With these reasons in mind the Public Works Department would like to utilize Sourcewell Contract Number 120716-NAF to purchase the Cab and Chassis of a 2021 Ford F-550 for the purchase price of \$42,631.68. Subsequently, the Public Works Department would like to Utilize Sourcewell Contract Number 080818-BNL for the purchase of Snow Plowing Upfitting and Equipment for the purchase price of \$46,721.00, for a total truck/equipment cost of \$89,352.68.

Public Works recommends the Village Board utilize funds from line item 01-03-5480 Capital Equipment in a not-to-exceed amount of \$91,000.00, which represents the budgeted amount, to National Auto Fleet Group and Bonnell Industries for the purchase of a Ford F-550 One Ton Dump with Snow Package Upfit. While the \$91,000.00 is over the quoted amount, Village Staff would like to be prepared for any last-minute change orders or alterations that could occur and alter the final purchase price even slightly. Any unused funds will remain in the Municipal Impact Fee balance.

for Bulk Rock Salt in an Amount Not-to-Exceed \$70,000

Every year the Village makes an acquisition of salt in order to provide quality snow and ice maintenance over the winter months. After the light snow season of 2019/2020 the Village has a full barn of salt ready to be used in the upcoming months. As winter is unpredictable, we always recommend having a purchase contract ready to keep our supplies built up and ensure we do not run out of salt during the winter months.

The village has solicited three quotes from major bulk rock salt providers in Illinois. Below you will find a table with pricing for salt on a per ton basis. The Village Board will also find the quotes attached to the staff memo. The following prices are all based on a requested purchase of 500 tons.

Morton Salt	Cargill Salt	Midwest Salt
\$76.90	\$80.00	\$85.00

The low bidder, Morton Salt, does not require a minimum purchase and allows salt to be ordered through an online portal which eases the salt ordering and tracking process. Because of the nominimum-purchase and allotment-over-the-quoted amount being dependent on availability we recommend increasing the amount over the original quoted amount to 900 tons.

Public Works recommends the Village Board utilize funds from line item 30-00-5462 (MFT Resolution) in a not-to-exceed amount of \$70,000.00 to Morton Salt for the purchase of 900 tons of bulk rock salt during the 2020/2021 snow season.

WHEREAS, the Village of Gilberts ("Village") has a Public Works Department, which maintains Village streets and other Village infrastructure, which activities include snow removal operations; and

WHEREAS, the Village annually budgets for the purchase of bulk rock salt for winter snow operations via the Motor Fuel Tax Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Village has filed an MFT Resolution with IDOT for the purchase of bulk rock salt utilizing MFT funds in the amount of \$70,000; and

WHEREAS, Public Works obtained multiple quotes for the purchase of bulk rock salt on a per ton basis, with the low quote being provided by Morton Salt;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GILBERTS, ILLINOIS, as follows:

- **Section 1. Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.
- <u>Section 2</u>. <u>Approval; Authorization</u>. The Village Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Village Administrator to execute an agreement and other necessary documents with Morton Salt for the purchase of bulk rock salt during the 2020/2021 snow season in an amount not-to-exceed \$70,000.
- Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the purchase of bulk rock salt from Morton Salt, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to Section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).
- <u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.
