2017 has flown by quickly and it's been a very busy year. Yet again, Gilberts completed the fiscal year with not only a balanced budget, but a surplus which increased our "rainy day" reserve. Our annual audit again found no deficiencies and we expect soon to receive our seventh consecutive annual Illinois Government Finance Officer Association's Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting Award. All of this happened despite uncertainty in the State of Illinois' budget and disbursement of local funds.

The Splash Pad saw a new pavilion, picnic tables, and larger play area. We installed bleachers at the Town Center Park baseball diamond along with new infields. In addition, we helped a local Boy Scout earn his Eagle Scout by building new dug-outs at Memorial Park.

If you've been north on Galligan Road, you've seen continued construction of homes in the Conservancy development. The last remaining townhouses were built in Town Center this year. Local builders report strong demand for houses. With new homes come new businesses like the new Shell and Dunkin' Donuts at Illinois 72 and Tyrell Road. Gilberts continues to be one of the fastest-growing communities in Illinois with a desirable quality of life.
