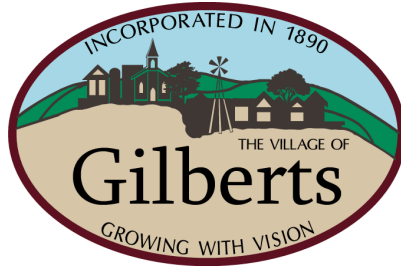

The Village of Gilberts platted in 1855 and incorporated in 1890 has a population of 6,364 as of the last special census conducted in 2008. The Village is located in Kane County and governed by a Village President and Board of Trustee form of government. PUBLIC MEETINGS

VILLAGE BOARD: The Village Board meets the first and third Tuesday of each month. The Village Board Work Sessions and the Committee of the Whole are held on the second and fourth Tuesday. The Village Board of Trustees is the corporate authority. The Village President is the Chief Administrator.

PLAN COMMISSION: The Plan Commission meets on the second and last Wednesday of the month. The purpose of this commission is to make recommendations to the Village Board relative to amendments to the Zoning Ordinance, special uses, annexations, planned unit developments and other matters directed by the Village Board.

ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS: The Zoning Board of Appeals meets when a public hearing is required. The purpose of this committee is to make recommendations to the Village Board relative to zoning variations, appeals, review of the zoning ordinance and other matters directed by the Village Board.

All public hearings are published in the Courier News and/or Daily Herald.

The Village, from time to time, seeks residents to serve on Committees or Sub-Committees. Interested parties should contact the Village President or the Village Clerk.
