

VILLAGE OF GILBERTS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF
SURPLUS PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF GILBERTS

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Gilberts that it is no longer necessary, useful, or in the best interest of the Village to retain ownership of the property described in this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Gilberts finds and determines that it will dispose of the property in a manner described in this Ordinance;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GILBERTS, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2: Disposal of Surplus Property. The President and Trustees find that the property described in Exhibit A attached to this Ordinance ("Surplus Property") is no longer necessary or useful to the Village. Therefore the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to direct the sale or disposal of the Surplus Property in the manner most appropriate to the Village. The Surplus Property shall be sold or disposed of in an "as is" condition.

Section 3: Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, other than the part affected by such decision.

Section 4: Upon its passage and approval according to law, this Ordinance shall, by authority of the Board of Trustees, be published in pamphlet form. Publication date: 10/18. Effective date: 10/28/2017

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval according to law.
