AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE 3 OF THE VILLAGE CODE TO CREATE A NEW LIQUOR LICENSE

WHEREAS, the Village is authorized by the Illinois Liquor Control Act, 235 ILCS 5/1 et seq. to license and regulate the sale of alcoholic beverages in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village has established local liquor license regulations in Chapter 2 of Title 3 of the Gilberts Village Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined it to be in the best interests of the Village and its residents to consider amendments to the Gilberts Village Code to create a new liquor license classification, as set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Board of the Village of Gilberts, Kane County, Illinois pursuant to its non-home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: The recitals set forth above are incorporated into this Section 1 as if set forth herein.

<u>Section 2</u>: Section 3-2-7 "Classification of Licenses" of Chapter 3-2 "Liquor Control" of the Gilberts Village Code shall be amended to add a new Subsection H, titled "Class G", which new Subsection 3-2-7H shall read as follows:

- "H. Class G: A class G license shall entitle a gas station, as the licensee, to sell beer and wine only, at retail, for consumption on the premises, and/or alcoholic liquor, at retail, for consumption off the premises where sold in the original package, subject to compliance with this chapter, including but not limited to the following provisions:
 - 1. The Basset training requirements of section 3-2-17 of this code.
 - 2. The restrictions contained in section 3-2-13 of this code regarding days and hours of sales of alcoholic liquors."

<u>Section 3</u>: Subsection A of Section 3-2-9 "Number of Licenses" of Chapter 3-2 "Liquor Control" of the Gilberts Village Code shall be amended by adding the following underlined text and deleting the following stricken text:

"A. The liquor commissioner shall be authorized to issue the following number of licenses to be outstanding at any one time:

<u>Section 4</u>: Paragraph A.1 of Section 2-4-19 "Liquor Licenses" of Chapter 2-4 "Fee Schedule" of the Gilberts Village Code shall be amended by adding the following underlined text:
