ORDINANCE NO. 21-2021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 11 OF TITLE 3 OF THE VILLAGE CODE REGARDING FOOD VENDOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, the Village has authority pursuant to Section 11-42-5 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 11/42-5, to “license, tax, regulate, or prohibit...transient vendors of merchandise” and to “license, tax, and regulate all places for eating;” and

WHEREAS, the Village has established local license regulations in Chapter 11 of Title 3 of the Gilberts Village Code for food vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees finds it to be in the best interests of the Village and its residents to amend the Village Code to allow to amend the licensing requirements for food vendors as set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Board of the Village of Gilberts, Kane County, Illinois pursuant to its non-home rule powers, as follows:

SECTION 1. RECITALS The recitals set forth above are incorporated into Section 1 as set forth herein.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 3-11-3 OF THE VILLAGE CODE. Section 3-11-3 “Application” of Chapter 11 “Food Vendors” of Title 3 of the Gilberts Village Code shall hereby be amended to read as follows (deletions in ~~striketrough~~, additions in **bold and double-underline**):

“3-11-3. - Application.

Application for a food vendor license under this chapter shall be submitted to the village clerk on forms provided by the village clerk for that purpose. The license application must be verified by oath or affidavit and include the following information.


- A. The name, address and statement of legal age of the applicant in the case of an individual; in the case of a copartnership, the persons entitled to share in the profits thereof, and in the case of a corporation for profit, or a club, the date of incorporation, the objects for which it was organized, the names and addresses of the officers and directors, owned by one person or his nominees, the name and address of such person.
- B. A list of names, addresses, social security numbers, ~~fingerprints~~, recent photographs and copies of drivers' licenses of all vehicle operators.
- C. ~~The applicant and all vehicle operators shall sign a waiver authorizing the village to conduct a background check on each driver including any replacement drivers who will operate the trucks. There shall be a \$50.00 nonrefundable fee for each background check required to be completed. No driver shall operate any vehicles within the village until the village completes a background check satisfactory to the village.~~
