My Fellow Gilberts Residents,

With winter quickly approaching and 2018 coming to an end, we reflect on the successful year it has been in the Village of Gilberts. Once again, our audit found no deficiencies and our "rainy day" funds were able to increase. I am pleased to report that the Village once again received a Government Finance Officer Association's Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting. This is a prestigious award that is awarded to very few municipalities in the State.

The Village has continued to grow with the arrival of new businesses and residents. The fourth and final building is beginning to be constructed in the Prairie Business Park behind the Shell Gas Station. These buildings bring much needed tax revenue to the Village and school system, without adding demand on services.

The Public Works Department has brought new light to the Village by replacing nearly all of the bulbs in our ornate streetlights with energy-efficient LEDs.

As we look toward the holiday season, I would like to invite you and your

HOLIDAY LIGHTS AND TREE DISPOSAL

The Village of Gilberts' Waste Hauler (MDC) shall pickup discarded Christmas trees placed on the curbside on the resident's normal pickup day after the holidays until January 31st. If trees are over 6 feet tall, they must be cut into two pieces.

To recycle your holiday lights, please place them in the designated bin that will be placed next to the Utility Bill Dropbox in the Village Hall parking lot. This program will be available from December 1st, 2018 until February 1st, 2019. Lights that will be accepted for this program are: Mini-lights (or Italian lights), C7 lights, C9 lights, rope lights, LED lights, extension cords, etc. All colors and lengths will be accepted. Garland, live greens, wreaths or other non-recyclables will not be accepted.

WATER BILL DROP BOX

For your convenience, The Village of Gilberts has a 24-hour drop box located in the parking lot of Village Hall where you may drop off water bill payments. Water bill payments can also be paid at either Village Hall or at our Public Works building with cash or check. You may also pay your water bill [online](#) as a one-time payment or sign up for auto-pay.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC WORKS

It is asked that trash collection containers (toters) not be placed in the streets but on the approaches to your driveways. Placing them on the streets makes the toters a hazard to vehicle traffic and makes snow-plowing activities much harder to complete.

Parking on Village streets after a two inch snowfall is a violation of the Village Code and may be subject to a ticket. Please remove the vehicles after a two inch snow and do not place them back on the street until snow removal activities by Public Works has been completed.

It is a violation of the Village Code to blow or shovel snow onto a public street. Direct your snow deposits to the grass areas of your lawn.
