Approval of this ordinance would authorize the disposal of several pieces of equipment that are obsolete and are no longer needed. The exhibit to the ordinance lists 8 pieces of equipment that are to be scrapped as they have no residual value. Staff will solicit sealed bids for the 1988 Ford tractor, which Public Works no longer uses, and the 2004 Ford Crown, a retired police car with over 120,000 miles that was replaced by the car purchased earlier this year. Staff recommend approval of the ordinance.

A. Motion to approve Resolution 25-2012, a Resolution authorizing the execution of an agreement between the Village of Gilberts and i3 American Inc. to provide for the construction and operation of FiberCity Gilberts

Approval of this resolution would authorize the execution of an agreement with i3 America Inc. to start the FiberCity Gilberts project, a public-private partnership that would extend a fiber optic network throughout Gilberts. At no cost to the Village, i3 would primarily use the Village's sanitary sewer system to install fiber optic cable adjacent to every address in the Gilberts. I3 would manage the open-content network, which will ultimately expand residents' and business' options for internet, cable and telecommunications providers. I3 is also committing to providing two strands of fiber to all of the Village's facilities, including the water towers, by August 31, 2013.

Staff recommend approval of the agreement, as it provides a major economic development advantage for the Village and an attractive infrastructure enhancement for residents. If approved, I3 proposes a joint marketing campaign to inform potential customers of the network proposal. A preliminary menu of services and estimated rates, based on a similar partnership between i3 and Sandy, OR, is provided for the Board's information. Please contact Assistant to the Administrator Bill Beith with any questions or requests for additional documentation.

October 16, 2012**

Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance

President Zirk called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He proceeded to lead those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call/ Establish Quorum

Members Present: Trustees Corbett, Clark, Mierisch, Farrell, Hacker and President Zirk. Trustee Zambetti arrived at 7:02 p.m. Others present: Administrator Keller, Finance Director Blocker, and Attorney Tappendorf.

Public Comment and Discussion

There were no comments from the public.

Consent Agenda

A motion was made by Trustee Clark and seconded by Trustee Farrell to approve the consent agenda as presented. Roll call: Vote: 5-ayes (Trustees Clark, Corbett, Farrell, Hacker, and Mierisch. Trustee Zambetti was not present at this time.) 0-nays, 0-abstained. Motion carried.

Items for Discussion

Higgins Road Industrial Park Conservation Area TIF District

Mike Weber, Director of PGAV, presented a slide show depicting the basic facts of a TIF, how a TIF works, and TIF eligible costs. He stated that a TIF cannot be used to finance construction of private buildings. He added that the TIF doesn't affect how property is assessed and taxed. The level of TIF financing is predicated on the amount of new private investment in taxable development projects. Most common TIF financing places risk on developers or bond holders, not the Village. He ended the slide show by showing before and after pictures of previous TIF projects.

Trustee Corbett asked Mr. Weber to go over the exclusions. The property north of Indian Trails was removed from the TIF because it isn't properly zoned, and it would have to be properly zoned before the TIF Agreement.

A discussion ensued regarding why the Koplos property was removed. Mr. Weber stated that it will remain in the PUD.

Trustee Zambetti inquired whether the TIF money could be used toward public improvements. Mr. Weber informed him that it could. However, TIF money couldn't be used for private parking lots or private landscaping.

Relocation fees are permissible, meaning TIF money can be used to relocate businesses. A discussion ensued between President Zirk, Trustee Zambetti, and Mr. Weber regarding relocation fees.

President Zirk inquired whether adjacent TIF Districts could share tax dollars. Mr. Weber explained that revenue could be transferred from one TIF to another.

President Zirk added that establishing a TIF District does not give businesses a tax break. Their taxes won't be lowered or raised. He added that bonds will not be purchased either.

Trustee Mierisch inquired whether bonds would be associated with an SSA. President Zirk explained that the SSA won't be used to cover the infrastructure cost.

The Board then reviewed the TIF schedule regarding the dates for meetings, public notices, mailings, and when ordinances have to be passed.

The Joint Review Board was discussed next. An explanation was made of who is on the Board. Representatives from the county, township, library, fire protection district, school district, and community college are on this advisory board.

Development Agreement by and between the Village of Gilberts and Koplos Living Trust and Interstate Partners LLC

President Zirk asked whether it was best to add Jeff Riemer to the Agreement. Attorney Tappendorf said it wasn't necessary. She said she could add language. However, it was unusual for a seller to participate in the agreement. Once Mark Ebacher from Interstate Partners stated that he would be purchasing the land in phases, it was decided that Mr. Riemer should be added to the Agreement.

Mr. Ebacher stated that he has an invested interest in the project since Interstate Partners is funding the TIF.

The Board proceeded to discuss business incentives. The Board discussed the possibility of sharing sales tax with businesses that generate sales tax. Trustee Mierisch stated that she would prefer that the incentives be included in a separate agreement and not included in the Development Agreement. Mr. Ebacher stated that some of the sales tax generating businesses could produce a sizable tax.

Each business will have a sales tax rebate with the Village. The length of the incentive will be stated in the rebate.

Trustee Clark inquired about the specifics of the referendum which passed authorizing a portion of the sales tax to be used to pay road program bonds and how it may affect the possible incentives. Attorney Tappendorf and Administrator Keller will review the paperwork.

President Zirk would like to see incentives to hire Gilberts' residents.

Trustee Zambetti added that he would like to see language in the Development Agreement regarding incentives.

The Board proceeded to go through the draft of the Development Agreement. President Zirk questioned "Eligible Costs" on page 3. It will read as follows: Those redevelopment costs incurred by a respective Owner that may be reimbursed under the Act, including costs incurred by a respective Owner prior to the Effective Date, but after the inducement, that are directly related to the development of the Property, and which costs are more specifically set forth in Exhibit H to this Agreement.

On Page 4 Trustee Mierisch questioned why a change was made from PGAV to Interstate. Administrator Keller clarified that for her.

On page 5 the final subdivision plat was discussed, including easements. Bob Gudmundson, engineer for Interstate Partners, stated that the final engineering comes in conjunction with the final plat. It was decided that Rierner will be subject to the Agreement.

On page 6, a majority of the Board doesn't feel comfortable with giving the Village Administrator the sole discretion to approve construction, improvements or development until the Final Engineering Plan, Final Landscaping Plan, Final Plat, and Final Plan are adopted and approved. This will be changed to the Village Board.

Mr. Ebacher suggested allowing the landscape plan to not be finalized.

On page 7, changes will be made to B.3. "Agricultural Use."

On page 8, the Board discussed General Standards. Attorney Tappendorf will better define the Subdivision Code.

Aster Road was discussed. Mr. Ebacher stated that it will become a public street. Attorney Tappendorf said that it will be referenced as a deviation.

Changes will be made to the Engineering Services on page 9.

On page 10, language will be added regarding the Tyrrell property to the South.

The section labeled "Trail" will be better defined.

"Schedule for Completion of Improvements" was discussed next. President Zirk wanted to verify that the off-site water main will be included in Phase I. Mr. Ebacher said it would. Attorney Tappendorf stated that the schedule could be included as an attachment.

While discussing "Dedication and Acceptance of Specified Improvements," President Zirk inquired if waivers were required from sub-contractors. Mr. Ebacher agreed that language could be added regarding that issue.

On page 11, G. "Issuance of Building and Occupancy Permits" President Zirk questioned what "reasonably" meant.

On page 12 "Designated Traffic Routes" and "Streets" were discussed. Changes will be made to these sections. They would like to see no parking allowed on streets. Mr. Ebacher stated that he would like to add in that Aster Road will be a public road.

On page 14, property taxes were discussed.

The first paragraph on page 15 will be removed.

A discussion ensued regarding "Eligible Cost Reimbursement." A majority of the Board chose to raise the amount of reimbursement to the owners to not exceed 90% of the taxes received. This will be increased from 70%.

The section "Approval of Payment" will be clarified.

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Page 5**

Covenants were discussed on page 16. President Zirk wants to make sure that someone is responsible for enforcing the covenants. Bankruptcies and liens were then discussed. Filing a lien against properties will be better defined (page 17).

On page 18, the Board wanted to verify that the recaptures have been fulfilled. Mr. Ebacher stated that they have been fulfilled.

“Performance Security” was discussed. Attorney Tappendorf will verify that the appropriate statutory language has been used.

In the top paragraph on page 21, the language concerning liens will be removed. This will be subject to state statute.

The Transferee Assumption Agreement was then discussed. This can be attached as an exhibit.

Mr. Ebacher then stated his frustration in the length of the Development Agreement. He added that he has worked in seven states, and has never once had an Agreement as lengthy as this one, and the Agreement with Elgin was only five pages long. He added that he will have to have an attorney look at the Development Agreement.

On page 23, President Zirk stated his concern regarding notifications being sent via email, since email addresses can change with staff turnaround.

On page 26, the required signature is from the President, not the Mayor. This change will be made.

The exhibits are incorrectly marked. This will be fixed as well.

The Board would like to see the Koplos property added to the TIF.

Ordinance 42-2012, an ordinance to rezone property to I-1 and approve a new planned unit development (PUD) and accompanying plans for Prairie Corporate Park

President Zirk will send his comments to Administrator Keller and Attorney Tappendorf.

The Board discussed the changes to **Exhibit H: Gilberts Corporate Park PUD, Industrial Lots.**

Under Permitted Uses, Industrial and Manufacturing Uses, an outside yard will be considered a Special Use. Under b.3. “except machinery and transportation equipment” will be removed. “Display assembly” will be added to the list. Under “Retail Business Uses,” “Boat sales and services” and “Motor vehicle sales and services” will be moved to Special Use. Under “Service Uses” “Exterminating and fumigating

services” and “Motor vehicle rental agencies” will remain on the list. “Taxicab offices and storage” will be moved to Special Use.

Under the Prohibited Uses listed on page 4, b.1. and 2. will be moved to Special Use. “Motor freight terminals,” “Exterminating and fumigating services,” “Motor vehicle rental agencies,” and Motor vehicle towing services” will all be made Special Uses. “Kennels” will be a Special Use and be included in the Office PUD as well. President Zirk would like to see a prohibition on donation boxes. Regulations on adult uses were then discussed.

Exhibit I: Gilberts Corporate Park PUD Retail/Service Commercial Lots was then discussed. Under Special Uses, Retail Business Uses, “Tire, battery and accessory sales and service” will be moved under Permitted Uses. “Bars and taverns” were discussed under Service Uses. It will be moved to a Permitted Use.

Under Prohibited Uses, “Kennels” will be moved to a Special Use. President Zirk would like to see a prohibition on donation boxes here as well.

The Board proceeded to discuss **Exhibit J:** Gilberts Corporate Park PUD, Office Lots Under Permitted Uses, Retail Business Uses, “Florist” will be added. “Agriculture implement sales and services” will be moved to Special Uses. Under Special Uses, Industrial and Manufacturing Uses, “except machinery and transportation equipment” will be removed after “Fabricated metal products.”

Road Program Updates

George Kannigan of Phoenix and Associates is taking care of some of the drainage concerns.

Mark Dachsteiner from B&W stated that all of the punch list items have been taken care of except for one, resident Patrick James of 528 Running Deer. He stated that Peter, Baker, & Son will be coming back to complete this outstanding issue.

Peter, Baker, & Son will be fixing the electric fence issue. The cost will be deducted from the final bill.

Peter, Baker, & Son has decided that they were not at fault regarding the issue with the post breaking the trailer window.

Peter, Baker, & Son wants to provide a \$20,000 maintenance bond in order to get a few areas complete. Mr. Dachsteiner will give a copy of the Bond to Attorney Tappendorf.

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF
PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF GILBERTS**

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Gilberts that it is no longer necessary, useful, or in the best interest of the Village to retain ownership of the personal property described in this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Gilberts finds and determines that it will dispose of the personal property in a manner described in this Ordinance;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GILBERTS, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2: **Disposal of Surplus Property.** The President and Trustees find that the personal property described in Exhibit A attached to this Ordinance ("Surplus Property") is no longer necessary or useful to the Village and that the Public Works Department for the Village of Gilberts is hereby authorized to direct the sale or disposal of the Surplus Property in the manner most appropriate to the Village. The Surplus Property shall be sold or disposed of in an "as is" condition.

Section 3: Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, other than the part affected by such decision.

Section 4: Upon its passage and approval according to law, this Ordinance shall, by authority of the Board of Trustees, be published in pamphlet form. Publication date: _____. Effective date:_____.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval according to law.

RE: i3 Agreement for Board meeting November 6, 2012

On Tuesday October 16, 2012, a draft agreement to provide a fiber optic network for the Village of Gilberts by i3 America was presented to the Village Board. This presentation generated some general questions about the agreement, generated some technical questions about the installation of the fiber in the waste water system and provided direction for a final version of the agreement.

The general and technical questions were summarized and submitted to i3 America. In response, we received written answers and proprietary technical documentation. The i3 answers are presented following each question, and where necessary, the technical documentation is referenced.

Incorporated into this document are references to i3-America technical documents which are designated by i3 as proprietary and controlled documents, not to be released to general distribution as they provide details related to installation and maintenance of the i3 FOCUS fiber optic cable product. These technical documents are incorporated by reference into the agreement.

The agreement states that i3 will not pay a fee to the Village for use of the sewer system but will provide two strands of fiber, at no cost, to all of the following municipal addresses by July 31, 2013.

- Village Hall 87 Galligan Road
- Police Department 86 Railroad Street
- Public Works/Finance Dept. 73 Industrial Drive
- Waste Water Treatment Plant 281 Raymond Drive
- Fresh Water Treatment Plant 320 Raymond Drive
- North Water Tower 19N056 Galligan Road
- Middle Water Tower 598 Sleeping Bear Lane
- South Water Tower 16 Tyrrell Road
- Rutland Fire Protection District 11 East Higgins Road
- Gilberts Elementary School 729 Paperbark Lane

Each content provider using the FiberCity Gilberts network will be required to establish a franchise agreement with the Village as is current telecommunications franchise practice.

The agreement contains language stating that the system will pass each residential and business address in the Village (as described in Agreement Exhibits 4 and 5) and build out will be according to order of demand with Construction to begin by early 2013. Order of demand is a marketing measure of subscribing premise's expressing a desire to receive content delivery from a specified provider through the Fibercity Network System. If this agreement is approved, Fibercity Gilberts and the Village of Gilberts will jointly begin an information campaign to inform residential and business users of the network. Based on the i3 and City of Sandy Oregon partnership, a preliminary menu of services and prices will be provided. As residents and businesses sign up, construction will begin in those areas with the highest concentration of users, and then proceed to the rest of the Village. Following are representative examples of speeds and pricing from Sandy Oregon. Actual prices in Gilberts will be set by the individual content provider.

i3 Response to Questions

Q1: In the case of waste water pipe repair, how is the fiber managed

A: During any planned repair where the FOCUS cable resides, Fibercity Gilberts will work with the Village council and appointed contractor to either work around the FOCUS cable or remove the FOCUS cable to facilitate the necessary planned work and then reinstate the FOCUS cable. i3-Group has a procedural control process to support such eventualities. Each document control number that pertains to such an event is listed in the Agreement with the Village, ensuring a contractor conforms to such documentation.

6) Emergency Cable Cutting and Removal from the Sewer

Q2: Is a video made of the pipes at time of installation to develop a baseline for pipe performance?

A: CCTV inspection is a 4 phase process: Design, pre, during and post cable installation.

- Step 1: Once a final design is established, i3 contractors will CCTV the entire route selected for the deployment of FOCUS cable to assess its suitability. Where further routes need to be considered as optional deployment routes, these will also have CCTV undertaken on them.
- Step 2: CTTV is carried out preinstall, a few days prior to scheduled installation on a particular section.
- Step3: CTTV is carried during installation to ensure the cable lies flat on the invert and secured in place.
- Step4: Post CCTV is carried out following installation to confirm all parties (Village, i3 and i3 contractor) are happy with the installation and the installation is then signed off by a Village appointed person. It must be noted that all copies of CCTV will be presented to the Village for review throughout the entire process and such copies become the property of the Village for their records. This presents sight of the Village wastewater system the Village may not have had to date.

Q3: Who is responsibility for blockage handled if the fiber is identified as a cause of the blockage?

A: The FOCUS system has been deployed throughout the world for over 10 years and has never created any blockage or had an adverse effect to the hydraulic of a wastewater system to date. Fibercity Gilberts is responsible for the reinstatement and associated cost should such an instance occur where FOCUS is identified to have caused the blockage.

Q5: What is the distribution plan for the fiber (front yard or back yard ROW)

A: Deployment of any Fibercity Gilberts fiber cable within the Village right of way will be subject to approval from Village council. Design options will be presented to Village council for approval prior to commencement of any construction.

Q6: Will there be distribution boxes similar to the U-Verse distribution boxes?

A: Contractors appointed by Fibercity Gilberts will be using below ground level distribution boxes. Should an instance occur where above ground level boxes are considered, this will only be used with Village council approval.

Q7: Question about anchoring the fiber to the bottom of the waste water pipe

A: i3-Group has a complete document control process to support the installation of FOCUS system. Each document control number is listed in the contract with the Village ensuring a contractor conforms to such process. Where the FOCUS cable passes through each and every manhole, a Manhole ID plate is located with the necessary contact details.

- 1) Installation of Cable within the Sewer
- 2) FOCUS System Post Installation Wastewater Maintenance Guidance Document

Q8: Granting i3 exclusive rights to the waste water pipes what happens in bankruptcy, with additional fiber competition, need to relocate lines, obligation to perform.

A: Fibercity Gilberts LLC will be a new legal entity, separating itself from external influences and will not commence any System build until long term agreements are in place with the Village and Service Provider(s). At such time, funds will be raised through an i3 lead consortium to cover the build and operational expenditure and be released in stage payments.

The infrastructure will remain the property of the i3 lead consortium. There is no reason for any other organization to investment the substantial funds to build a fiber to the premise infrastructure in the Village once Fibercity Gilberts is in place, as Fibercity Gilberts encourages many Service Providers to deliver service over its System. It is in the commercial interest of the Service Providers to deliver competitive service to subscribing premises and ensure customer retention given the long term agreement they will have in place with the i3 lead consortium.

Q9: A suggestion was made to insert a clause stipulating the exclusive access to the waste water system is tied to providing service.

A: i3 America has agreed to ensure the FOCUS cable is completed in the Village by end of July 2013. Once the build starts, it is in the interest of everyone involved to quickly connect subscribers to see revenue return.

Q10: For those areas without curb and gutter, keep the fiber out of the ditch

A: Noted. (Also addressed in Question 5).

Q11: Specify the industrial areas (and the municipal address exhibit) as the priorities. (New pending development wants immediate service as a condition to locate)

A: i3 America cannot guarantee or set any address as priority. A design will be presented to the Village council and such design will be deployed in areas of demand where pre-signup subscribers have been secured. However, i3 America does agree to install the FOCUS cable (Truck fiber) by end of July 2013; consequently this will pass a considerable number of requested buildings due to their location within the Village.

It is not in the interest of all involved to deploy an unsustainable model where no revenue is being returned so early into the build. i3 America encourages the Village to provide input into the approach and phase of the build-out as Fibercity Gilberts has to commit to delivering particular levels of monthly return to the i3 lead consortium otherwise no capital funds will be released.

Q12: What about users outside of municipal boundaries? Develop a model for service provision based on parks out of district fee structure.

A: Where additional communities require a Fibercity, i3 America will engage with that community to present a similar offering. I3 America agree to pass each premise as listed within the Agreement and provide connections to such premise when a Service Provider confirms that premise has entered into an agreement with them to take service over the System. Fibercity Gilberts is exclusive to the Village and those premises listed in the Agreement. Any premise established within the Village following the signed Agreement will be treated as an addendum to the Agreement.

Q13: Develop a cost analysis for users. Position connection fees lower as the Village is not taking \$'s from i3.

- A: Fibercity Gilberts will not charge a System connection fee to any premise listed in the Agreement, including the cost of the ONT that is mounted on a premise wall. Any costs to connect the subscriber from the wall mounted ONT to a subscriber's home equipment is a cost to be agreed between the subscriber and their Service Provider; this including any service the subscriber receives from a Service Provider over the System.
- Design: The System will be designed for fiber to pass each premise listed within the Agreement, with fiber provisioned to support future developments listed in each Exhibit. Where premises have pre-signed to receive service from a Service Provider over the System, the build contractor will install a fiber and ONT to such premise wall as they pass the premise during build-out.

- Securing a high percentage take-up rate of premises either pre-build or during the build is the most effective use of capital funds. However, an i3 contractor will return and connect each premise that request connection to the System upon confirmation from a Service Provider that the premise has entered into an agreement with them to receive service over the System.

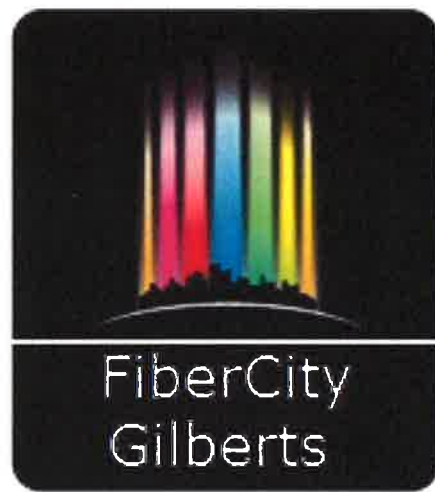

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AGREEMENT

This Agreement (hereinafter, the "Agreement") is made between the Village of Gilberts, Illinois (hereinafter, the "Village" or "Authority") and FiberCity Gilberts LLC (hereinafter, the "Grantee").

The Village desires to enter into this Agreement with the Grantee for the right to construct, maintain and operate the System, on the terms and subject to the conditions set forth herein.

SECTION 1: Definition of Terms

1.1 Terms.

For the purpose of this Agreement, the following terms, phrases, words, and abbreviations shall have the meanings ascribed to them below.

"Act" means, collectively, Title 9, Chapter 8, Article C of the Village of Gilberts Village Code, commonly known as "Construction of Facilities in Public Rights of Way", and any other applicable Federal or State statute, law, or regulation or other Village of Gilberts ordinance by which the Village has authorized the execution, delivery and performance of this Agreement.

"Agreement" means the initial authorization, or renewal thereof, issued by the Village President, whether such authorization is designated as a, registration, permit, license, resolution, contract, certificate, ordinance or otherwise, which authorizes construction and operation of the System. Agreement also includes any amendments or modifications hereto.

"Authority" means the Village of Gilberts, Illinois including its Board of Trustees, Commissions and Committees or the lawful successor, transferee, designee, or assignee thereof.

"Effective Date" shall be the date of execution of the Agreement by the Village and Grantee.

"Facilities" means the Point of Presence (PoP) at 73 Industrial Drive, Gilberts, Illinois, 60136, which is the building and related electronic and fiber facilities [which are designated and agreed upon and set forth on Exhibit 1] are located in the Village from which



the fiber optic cables will be deployed to a Premise Wall.

"Boundary" means the present legal boundaries of the Village as of the Effective Date, and shall also include any additions thereto or subtractions thereof, by annexation or other legal means.

"Grantee" shall have the meaning set forth in the preamble hereof

"Law" shall include all federal, state or local laws, regulations or rules, and any other action by an authorized entity or person that has the effect of law.

"Person" means any natural person or any association, firm, partnership, joint venture, corporation, or other legally recognized entity, whether for-profit or not-for profit, but shall not mean the Village.

"PoP" means point of presence, the physical central location of the Facilities.

"Premise Wall" means the wall of the business or residence to which the fiber optic cable will terminate, which is part of the System.

"Public Way" shall mean the Right(s) of Way, as such term is defined in Section 9-8C-2 of the Village Code.

"Service Provider" means a person who will provide telecommunications, information, or video programming services at retail over the System to any subscribing premise that requests all or a part of such services.

"System" means a neutral-host, fiber optic network, located within the Boundary that will allow Service Providers to deliver telecommunications, information, or video programming services to subscribing premises, with the fiber optic cable to be laid from the PoP through the Public Way and to the Premise Wall. The Grantee will use its reasonable commercial efforts to contract System access to one or many Service Providers who have an intention to deliver subscriber services. So long as the Grantee does not provide telecommunications, information, or video programming services, it is not a Service Provider. No Service Provider shall be granted access which is mutually exclusive with any other Service Provider except to the extent such exclusivity is required by reason of technical incompatibility.

"Sewer System" means the sanitary and storm sewer utility systems owned and operated by the Village of Gilberts within the Boundary.



SECTION2: Grant of Authority

2.1. Grant of Agreement.

2.1.1 The Authority hereby grants to the Grantee under the Act a non-exclusive Agreement, which authorizes the Grantee to construct, maintain and operate the System among, upon, across, above, over, under, or in any manner connected with Public Ways within the Boundary, and for that purpose to erect, install, construct, repair, replace, reconstruct, maintain, operate or retain in, on, over, under, upon, across, or along any Public Way and all extensions thereof and additions thereto: wires, cables, ducts, conduits, vaults, manholes, pedestals, appliances, attachments, and other related property or equipment as may be necessary or appurtenant to the System.

2.1.2 The Authority hereby grants to the Grantee an exclusive Agreement which authorizes Grantee to construct, maintain and operate the portions of the System within and through such parts of the Sewer System as are necessary and convenient for the operation of the System. For the purpose of this Agreement, the exclusivity granted herein is solely with respect to installation of the System in the Sewer System. The portions of the System which may be erected, installed, constructed, repaired, replaced and maintained in the Sewer System shall be subject to the exclusive and sole discretion of the Authority. In the event there is no active Service Provider providing telecommunications, information, or video programming services at retail over the System for any period of not less than twelve (12) months following the commencement of this Agreement, the exclusivity granted hereby shall be rescinded.

2.1.3 In consideration of the authority granted herein, Grantee will enter into agreements with one or more Service Providers for purposes of selling telecommunications, information, or video programming services at retail using the System. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to grant any authority to a Service Provider with respect to the sale at retail of any telecommunications, information, or video programming services.

2.2. Term of Agreement.

The term of the Agreement hereunder shall commence on the Effective Date and expire twenty (20) years from the date hereof. This Agreement may be renewed upon the mutual assent of the parties for two (2) successive five (5) year terms, on the same terms and conditions, provided that there is no uncured event of default at the time of renewal.



2.3 Fees, Expenses and other Charges.

Except as expressly set forth herein, each party shall bear and be responsible for all of its own costs, fees and expenses incurred in executing and performing under this Agreement.

2.3.1 Any Service Provider that delivers content over the System to a subscribing premise will pay the respective fees and taxes applicable to such service, including but not limited to franchise fees, service provider fees, and simplified municipal telecommunications taxes.

2.3.2 In consideration for the exclusive right to occupy the waste water assets, Grantee shall provide the Authority with two strands of fiber to each address listed in Exhibit 2 with no limitation to the content carried on that fiber.

2.3.3 In further consideration for the exclusive right to occupy the waste water assets, Grantee shall install the aforementioned two (2) strands of fiber at each address listed in exhibit 2 no later than August 31, 2013.

2.4 Reservation of Authority.

Nothing in this Agreement shall (A) abrogate the right of the Authority to perform any public works or public improvements of any description, (B) be construed as a waiver of any codes or ordinances of general applicability promulgated by the Authority, (C) be construed as a waiver or release of the rights of the Authority in and to the Public Ways, or (D) be a waiver or result in the diminution of the Authority's police power.

SECTION 3: The System

3.1 Permits and General Obligations.

The Grantee shall abide by the lawful rules and regulations of the Village, including but not limited to Title 9, Chapter 8, Article C, "Construction of Facilities in Public Rights of Way." Construction, installation, and maintenance of the System shall be performed in a safe, thorough, workmanlike and reliable manner using materials of good and durable quality. All transmission and distribution structures, and equipment installed by Grantee for use in the System in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be located so as to minimize the interference with the proper use of the Sewer System and Public Ways and the rights and reasonable convenience of property owners who own property that adjoins any such Public Way.



3.2 Conditions on Street Occupancy.

3.2.1. Relocation at request of the Authority. The Grantee shall comply with Section 9-8C-12 of the Code. Grantee shall also not be responsible for the cost associated with relocating the System to accommodate a private development project or the construction of a new school, hospital or other public entity that affects the Public Way, but the Grantee shall remain responsible for costs associated with relocating the System to accommodate all other public projects of the Village affecting the Public Way. The Village shall use its reasonable efforts to reduce or keep Grantee's costs of compliance with this provision to a minimum, provided the Village's costs take precedence over Grantee's costs in planning future public improvements.

3.2.2. Relocation at request of Third Party. The Grantee shall, upon reasonable prior written request of any Person holding a permit issued by the Authority to move any structure, temporarily move its fiber optic cables to permit the moving of such structure; provided (i) the Grantee may impose a reasonable charge on any Person for the movement of its fiber optic cables, and such charge may be required to be paid in advance of the movement of its fiber optic cables; and (ii) the Grantee is given not less than fifteen (15) business days advance written notice to arrange for such temporary relocation.

3.2.3. Restoration of Public Ways. Grantee shall comply with Section 9-8C-13.

3.2.4. Safety Requirements. The Grantee shall, at its own cost and expense, undertake all necessary and commercially reasonable efforts to maintain its work sites and the System, consistent with industry practices, in a safe manner and in normal order and repair in order to prevent failures and accidents that may cause damage, injuries or nuisances. All work undertaken on the System shall be performed in substantial compliance with applicable federal, state, and local regulations. The System shall not unreasonably endanger or interfere with the safety of Persons or property in the Boundary. The Grantee shall maintain a labor force sufficient to ensure compliance with this provision.

3.2.5 Distribution Boxes. Distribution boxes located within commercial and residential neighborhoods shall be installed below grade except with the prior written consent of the Village Administrator.

3.2.6 Non-Sewer System storm utility facilities. Where the System is installed within a right-of-way constructed with a "rural cross-section," or without curb and gutter, the System shall be constructed so as to not reduce the storm volume capacity of the ditches and culverts.



3.3 Conditions on Sewer System Occupancy.

3.3.1 Manner of Installation. The System shall be installed in the Sewer System in substantial compliance with Grantee Document No. 000-FS-MS-010, Installation of Cable within the Sewer (“Installation Specifications”), attached hereto as Exhibit 8 and incorporated as though fully set forth herein; provided that the Installation Specifications may be amended by authorized representatives of the Authority and the Grantee for the purpose of conforming the specifications to industry custom and practice established in the United States.

3.3.2 Condition of Sewer System. Prior to and immediately following either the (i) installation of the System in the Sewer System, or (ii) temporary relocation of the System for Sewer System maintenance purposes, the Grantee and Authority shall cooperate to establish, record and document the physical condition of the Sewer System. The recording and documentation of the physical condition of the Sewer System shall be performed in substantial compliance with Grantee Document 000-FS-MS-070, CCTV Camera Inspections (“Televising Specifications”), attached hereto as Exhibit 9 and incorporated as though fully set forth herein; provided that the Televising Specifications may be amended by authorized representatives of the Authority and the Grantee for the purpose of conforming the specifications to industry custom and practice established in the United States. Records of the inspection of the physical condition of the Sewer System shall be maintained for at least five (5) years.

3.3.3 Remediation of Sewer System Failures. Grantee shall indemnify and hold the Authority harmless for (a) any damage caused to the Sewer System or material impairment of the Sewer System’s functionality resulting from the installation, operation, maintenance, repair and replacement of the System, and (b) any claims, liabilities, damages, fines, penalties, judgments and/or judicial or administrative orders arising from any personal injury, death, property damage or destruction, or violations of applicable law resulting from the installation, operation, maintenance, repair and replacement of the System in the Sewer System.

3.3.4 Maintenance, Repair and Relocation of System. Following the installation of the System in the Sewer System, Grantee shall maintain, repair, replace and, if necessary, temporarily relocate the System in substantial compliance with Grantee Document 000-FS-GD-006, FOCUS System Post Installation Wastewater Maintenance Guide Document (“Maintenance Specifications”), and Grantee Document 000-FS-MS-030, Emergency Cable Cutting and Removal from the Sewer (“Removal and Relocation Specifications”), collectively attached hereto as Group Exhibit 10 and incorporated as though fully set forth herein; provided that the Maintenance Specifications and the Removal and Relocation Specifications may be amended by authorized representatives of the Authority and the



Grantee for the purpose of conforming the specifications to industry custom and practice established in the United States.

3.3.5 Cooperation. Grantee shall cooperate with the Authority in taking all commercially reasonable measures requested by the Authority for the purpose of ensuring the proper operation of the Sewer System.

SECTION 4: Construction and Facilities

4.1. Construction of System.

The parties agree the Grantee will construct a System that passes every existing premises within Exhibit 2 (municipal addresses), Exhibit 3 (residential addresses), and Exhibit 4 (business addresses), and provision expansion of the fiber to serve pending and future development within Exhibit 5 and Exhibit 6. Construction of the i3 FOCUS fiber optic cable system will be built out according to order of demand with Construction to begin by early 2013 with two strands of fiber to each municipal address listed in Exhibit 2 no later than August July 31, 2013. Order of demand is a marketing measure of subscribing premise's expressing a desire to receive content delivery from a specified provider through the System.

4.2 Designation and Construction of Facilities.

4.2.1 Facilities Access. The Grantee shall during the term and all renewal terms hereof have access to and rights to use the Facilities, subject to applicable law, at its own cost and expense. The Facilities will house the equipment necessary in Grantee's judgment to enable the System to operate.

4.2.2 Construction Techniques – Right of Way. Except to the extent approved by the Department of Public Works, Grantee shall comply with Section 9-8C-10. Authority agrees to work cooperatively with Grantee in reviewing all potential construction methods.

4.2.3 PoP location and Material Storage. Village will lease space to the Grantee for the installation of Grantee's PoP as set forth in Exhibit A, located behind the Village of Gilberts Public Works building at 73 Industrial Dive, Gilberts, Illinois, 60136. The design of the PoP will allow 24/7 access without Village of Gilberts personnel to be present to perform installation, operation, maintenance, replacement, repair, or other activities necessary to maintain the network in operating condition. Village will assist with a space for the housing of materials to build the System.



4.3 Subscriber Connections

When a Service Provider confirms a subscriber has entered into an agreement to accept services over the System a fiber strand will be terminated at the subscriber Premise Wall, via a drop from the System and in a manner to be determined by the Grantee. The location and the method of the drop to the premise wall will vary depending on the circumstances of the subscriber location.

The following will apply to the connection between the System and the Premise Wall of each subscriber:

- i) Village will assist Grantee in securing private property easement access rights, when necessary, to connect the System from the subscriber property boundary to the Premise Wall.
- ii) Where possible, Grantee shall install subscriber drops underground.
- iii) Grantee shall not charge subscribers a connection fee for installation to the System. Nothing herein shall be construed to relate to the service contract between the subscriber and the Service Provider.

SECTION 5: Oversight and Regulation by Authority

5.1 Oversight of Agreement.

Grantee agrees to comply with Title 9, Chapter 8, Article C. To the extent such ordinance clearly conflicts with the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail, except where such conflict arises from the Authority's lawful exercise of its police powers. Nothing in this Section 5.1 shall be construed to limit the Authority's ability to enforce the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

5.2 Compliance with Applicable Laws.

Subject to Section 5.1 of this Agreement, the Grantee shall, at all times during the life of this Agreement, be subject to and comply in all material respects with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, rules regulations and policies, as now or hereafter adopted or amended.



5.3. Confidentiality and Proprietary Information.

5.3.1. Treatment of Confidential and Proprietary Information. Though all information is subject to Illinois Freedom of Information Act, the Village represents that it will use all reasonable efforts to claim available exemptions under state Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) law, and will notify Grantee if a FIOA request is received in connection with that proprietary information. All materials that Grantee believes are proprietary will be labeled "Proprietary, privileged and confidential". The Authority and Grantee agree that all Exhibits containing technical specifications for the installation, maintenance, repair, replacement and relocation of the System shall be considered confidential and proprietary trade secrets that are exempt from disclosure under FOIA.

5.4. Transfer of Agreement.

Neither the Grantee nor any other Person may transfer the System or this Agreement without the prior written consent of the Authority. Consent shall be required, however, for:

- (i) a transfer in trust, by mortgage, hypothecation, or by assignment of any rights, title, or interest of the Grantee in this Agreement or the System in order to secure indebtedness, provided that the security holder shall execute an agreement reasonably acceptable to the Village that it shall operate the System for the term of this Agreement in the event it enforces any or all of its rights relative to Grantee, or
- (ii) a transfer to an entity directly or indirectly owned or controlled by or controlling or under common control with Grantee.

SECTION 6: Insurance and Indemnity

6.1. Insurance; Indemnification.

6.2.1 Throughout the term of this Agreement, the Grantee shall, at its own cost and expense, Comply with Section 9-8C-5 of the Village Code.

6.2.2 The Authority shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Grantee, its members, directors, officers, employees, and agents and its and their respective affiliates, successors and assigns from and against any liability or claims resulting from property damage or bodily injury (including accidental death), which arise solely out of any act or



omission for which the Village may be held liable under the Laws of the State of Illinois, provided that the Grantee shall give Authority written notice of its obligation to indemnify the Grantee as soon as reasonably possible or practical to do so following the proper and legal receipt of a claim or action pursuant to this Section 6.2 and in any case no longer than ten (10) days after receipt. If the Grantee determines that it is necessary for it to employ separate counsel, the costs for such separate counsel shall be the responsibility of the Grantee.

SECTION 7: System Description and Service

7.1. System Description and Service.

The System shall be designed in a manner using fiber optic cable using the Sewer System and Public Way emanating from the PoP to the Public Way and from there to the Premises Wall. The network shall conform to the Village of Gilberts Municipal Code including Title 12, Telecommunications and Wireless Services, Section 9-8C-4 Permit requirements, and Section 2-4-2 Performance Bond. The parties will collaborate on the System design from the Facilities, through the Public Way and to the Premise Wall.

7.2 Project Obligations.

7.2.1 Obligations of Village In addition to all other obligations mentioned elsewhere in this Agreement, Village will have the following obligations:

- (a) Provide a single point of contact (“SPOC”) for Grantee, which SPOC will be responsible for addressing all administrative issues related to the System, providing coordination across Village departments and serving as a communications and troubleshooting resource for Grantee. Nothing herein shall be construed as a delegation of legislative authority to the SPOC.
- (b) Offer the full cooperation of all Village departments with respect to relevant issues on the System. Such cooperation will be supervised by the SPOC
- (c) Participate in regular status meetings for the coordination of all matters related to the System.
- (d) Provide quick, diligent review of all applications for permits, including permits or other necessary items for construction work on the System within Village Public Way.
- (e) Cooperate with Grantee on all publicity and public relations for the



System.

7.2.2 Obligations of the Grantee In addition to all other obligations mentioned elsewhere in this Agreement, the Grantee will have the following obligations:

(a) Work closely with the SPOC of the Village and relevant Village departments with respect to the construction of the System.

(b) Comply with all requirements of Village for permit and Public Way use applications, including but not limited to Title 9, Article 8C of the Village Code.

(c) Build the System to pass every premise as listed in Exhibit 2 through to Exhibit 4 and provision fiber to serve future development within Exhibit 5 and Exhibit 6. The parties will collaborate on the System design to serve Exhibit 5 and Exhibit 6.

(d) Distribution of content within a single premise is the responsibility of the premise owner. That owner may contract with a Service Provider to install internal network components to deliver content services as directed by the premise owner.

7.3 Boundary Limitation.

7.3.1 The System shall exclusively serve subscribers located within the Boundary and not be used to facilitate the construction and operation of a system serving areas outside the Boundary.

SECTION 8: Enforcement and Termination of Agreement

8.1. Notice of Violation or Default.

In the event the Authority believes that ~~the~~ Grantee has not complied with the material terms of this Agreement, the Authority shall promptly notify the Grantee in writing with specific details regarding the exact nature of the alleged noncompliance or default.

8.2. Grantee's Right to Cure or Respond.

The Grantee shall have thirty (30) days from the receipt of the Authority's notice described in Section 8.1, above:

(a) to respond to the Authority, contesting the assertion of noncompliance or



default, or

(b) to cure such default, or

(c) in the event that, by nature of the default, such default cannot be cured within the thirty (30) day period, initiate reasonable steps to remedy such default, notify the Village of Gilberts of the steps being taken, the projected date that they will be completed, and continue to exercise diligence in executing the cure to completion. Such date shall be accepted as an extension of time to cure upon the written consent of the Village of Gilberts.

8.3. Default.

In the event ~~the~~ Grantee fails to respond to the Authority's notice described in Section 8.1, above, or in the event that the alleged default is not remedied within said thirty (30) days or the later date agreed upon pursuant to Section 8.2 above, the Grantee shall be deemed in default and subject to the remedies herein described and otherwise available at law and in equity.

8.4. Enforcement.

Subject to applicable federal and state law and the preceding procedural steps, in the event the Authority determines that the Grantee is in default of any provision of the Agreement, the Authority may:

8.4.1. Seek specific performance of any provision which reasonably lends itself to such remedy, as an alternative to damages or seek other equitable relief; or

8.4.2. In the case of a substantial default of a material provision of the Agreement, declare the Agreement to be revoked in accordance with the following:

- (i) The Authority shall give written notice to the Grantee of its intent to revoke the Agreement on the basis of a material default or a pattern of noncompliance by the Grantee. The notice shall set forth with specificity the exact nature of the material default or pattern of noncompliance. The Grantee shall have thirty (30) days from the receipt of such notice to object in writing and to state its reasons with specificity for such objection. In the event the Authority has not received a satisfactory response from the Grantee, it may then seek termination of this Agreement. In the event the Authority seeks termination of this Agreement, the Authority shall schedule a public hearing to be held at the next regularly scheduled public meeting of the Authority for the purpose



of allowing the Authority the opportunity to present its basis of termination and to allow the Grantee the opportunity to respond. The Authority shall cause to be served upon the Grantee, at least ten (10) days prior to such public meeting, a written notice specifying the time and place of such hearing and stating its intent to request termination of the Agreement.

- (ii) At the designated hearing, the Authority shall give the Grantee an opportunity to state its position on the matter, including the presentation of documents or other materials or speakers necessary to present its position, after which, the Authority shall determine whether or not the Agreement shall be revoked. The public meeting shall be on the record and a written transcript shall be made available to the Grantee, at the Grantee's sole expense, within ten (10) business days. The decision of the Authority shall be in writing and shall be delivered to the Grantee in the manner set forth in Section 11.2, herein and shall be considered a final action of the Authority on the matter of revocation.

8.4.3 The Authority may, at its sole discretion, take any lawful action that it deems appropriate to enforce its rights under the Agreement in lieu of revocation.

8.5 Authority Breach or Default.

In the event the Grantee believes that the Authority has not complied with the material terms of this Agreement, it shall promptly notify the Authority in writing with specific details regarding the exact nature of the alleged noncompliance or default. The other terms and provisions of section 8.2, 8.3 and 8.4.1 hereof shall then apply except simply reversing Authority with Grantee and Grantee with Authority. The sole remedy available to Grantee for a breach or default by the Authority shall be specific performance or other available equitable relief. In no case shall the Authority be liable to Grantee for any special, indirect, incidental, consequential, or exemplary damages, including, without limitation, any damages resulting from loss of use, loss of data, interruption of business activities, or failure to realize profits arising out of the operation of the System, regardless of whether a claim is based on a theory of contract or tort, including negligence and strict liability. It is understood and agreed that any breach of the exclusivity provisions and term, not in limitation of other provisions set forth herein, are material.

8.6 Limitation on Liability.

EXCEPT FOR A PARTY'S INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS, IN NO EVENT



WILL EITHER PARTY BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER PARTY FOR ANY INDIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, RELIANCE, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES OF ANY KIND OR NATURE WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ANY LOST PROFITS, LOST REVENUES, LOST SAVINGS, OR HARM TO BUSINESS. EACH PARTY HEREBY RELEASES THE OTHER PARTY, ITS SUBSIDIARIES AND AFFILIATES, AND THEIR RESPECTIVE TRUSTEES, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, MANAGERS, EMPLOYEES, AND AGENTS, FROM ANY SUCH CLAIM.

8.7 Transition upon Termination

In the event of termination of this Agreement upon the expiration of this Agreement at the end of the term (and any renewal term), the parties may negotiate a commercially reasonable operating agreement for the continued use of the existing System, which could involve ownership and operation of the System by Village or a third party and at the same time compensate Grantee.

In the event of termination of this Agreement upon the expiration of this Agreement at the end of the term (and any renewal term), the Village will have the right and option, but not the obligation, to purchase the fiber network from Grantee at any time prior to such a termination. Village shall exercise its aforesaid option by giving Grantee written notice of Village's election to exercise its option no less than 120 days prior to the end of the then existing term. The Village's exercise notice shall specify the date, time and place of closing, which date (the "Closing") shall be neither earlier than 30 days nor later than 150 days after the notice given. In connection with this option, the parties further agree as follows:

- (a) The purchase price to be paid by Village, or its designee, for the System (the "Purchase Price") shall be the "Fair Market Value of the System", which shall be mutually agreed upon Village and Grantee; however, if the parties do not agree as to the Fair Market Value of the System within thirty (30) days after the Exercise Date, then each party shall choose a "Qualified Expert" who shall make such determination of the Fair Market value of the System as of the Exercise Date and submit the same to the other party (together with the information forming the basis for such determination) within seventy five (75) days after the Exercise Date (with each party paying the fee for its own Qualified Expert), but if the two Qualified Experts do not agree as to the Fair Market Value for the System within fifteen (15) days thereafter, the two Qualified Experts shall promptly jointly select a third Qualified Expert. Within 30 days after his or her appointment, the third Qualified Expert shall select one of the two initially submitted appraisals as the Fair Market Value of the System and such selection shall be binding upon the parties.



(b) For purposes hereof, the term “Qualified Expert” shall mean an independent unaffiliated third party with expertise and knowledge about fiber networks of this kind and the market value of the same, taking into account the technology, infrastructure, depreciation, current liabilities, the parties’ previous contributions to the System, customer base, service speeds and other relevant market factors. The fee of the third Qualified Expert, if any, shall be paid by the party whose determination of the Fair Market Value of the System is ~~not~~ selected by the third Qualified Expert. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Village may terminate the Agreement without giving 180 days notice if Grantee is in default and Village does not elect to exercise its option to purchase the System hereunder.

In the event of termination and non-renewal of this Agreement upon the expiration of this Agreement at the end of the term (and any renewal term), and no successor owner of the System is identified, the System may be abandoned in place. In the event the System is abandoned in place the Authority shall incur no liability for any maintenance, repair or replacement of any component of the System or for any damage caused to the System, regardless of whether it is by natural or man-made



SECTION 9: Miscellaneous Provisions

9.1 Force Majeure

Neither party shall not be held in default under, or in breach or noncompliance with, the provisions of this Agreement, nor suffer any enforcement or penalty relating to noncompliance or default (including termination, cancellation or revocation of the Agreement), where such noncompliance or alleged defaults occurred or were caused by strike, riot, war, earthquake, flood, unusually severe rain or snow storm, hurricane, tornado or other catastrophic act of nature, labor disputes, failure of utility service necessary to construct or maintain the System, governmental, administrative or judicial order or regulation or other event that is reasonably beyond the Grantee's ability to anticipate or control. This provision also covers work delays caused by waiting for utility providers to service or monitor their own utility infrastructure on which the Grantee's fiber optic cable and/or equipment may be deployed, as well as unavailability of materials and/or qualified labor to perform the work necessary. To claim a force majeure event the affected party shall send notice to the other party within three (3) business days of the onset of the cause giving rise to the force majeure event. Thereafter, the delay granted by the force majeure shall only be for so long as the cause of the event continues. Either party may give notice to the other of the abatement of the cause giving rise to the force majeure event.

9.2 Notice

All notices shall be in writing and shall be sufficiently given and served upon the other party by hand delivery, overnight mail, or by facsimile with confirmed transmission and addressed as follows:

Notices shall be deemed received the same day with delivery upon hand delivery, and the next business day with delivery upon overnight mail, electronic mail, or by facsimile.

9.3. Entire Agreement

This Agreement, including all Exhibits, embodies the entire understanding and agreement of the Authority and the Grantee with respect to the subject matter hereof. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or other agreements whether written, verbal, or otherwise between the Grantee and the Authority that are in conflict with the provisions of this Agreement are hereby declared superseded and this Agreement shall control.

9.4. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this Agreement is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body, or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

9.5. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be deemed to be executed in the Village of Gilberts, State of Illinois, and shall be governed in all respects, including validity, interpretation and effect, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Illinois, as applicable to contracts entered into and performed entirely within the State, irrespective of conflict of laws principles. The parties consent to venue for any disputes arising under this Agreement being in any state court serving Kane County or any federal court having jurisdiction thereof.



9.6. Modification

No provision of this Agreement shall be amended or otherwise modified, in whole or in part, except by an instrument, in writing, duly executed by the Authority and the Grantee, which amendment shall be authorized on behalf of the Authority through the adoption of an appropriate resolution or order by the Authority, as required by applicable law.

9.7. No Third Party Beneficiaries

Nothing in this Agreement or in any prior agreement is or was intended to confer third-party beneficiary status on any member of the public to enforce the terms of such Agreement.

9.8. No Waiver of Rights

Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as a waiver of any rights, substantive or procedural. Grantee may have under federal or state law unless such waiver is expressly stated herein.
