C. Job Description for Community Service Officer position

Staff have prepared a draft job description for the Community Service Officer, a new part-time position to be assigned to the Police Department. This would be a non-sworn civilian position that would be assigned duties that do not require a sworn officer, such as traffic and parking enforcement, picking up stray animals, relaying vehicles and records and other support functions.

Staff anticipate that the position would be paid \$14-\$15 per hour, depending on qualifications, which is comparable to the Village's other part-time non-sworn positions. For the remainder of this fiscal year, funding this position at 16 hours per week would cost approximately \$6,450. However, this cost is not included in the Police Department's personnel budget and would require an adjustment. The budget is performing as projected so far with some minor deviations on individual lines, but there is not an obvious revenue surplus or savings to fund this position. If so directed by the Board, Staff will incorporate this position into the working budget, recognizing that the additional personnel cost will need to come from savings found elsewhere over the remaining seven months in the fiscal year.

Staff request the Board's feedback and direction on the proposed position and job description. If so directed, Staff will prepare the job description for the Board's approval at the October 16 meeting. If you need additional information prior to the meeting, please contact me, Finance Director Marlene Blocker or Chief Steve Williams.

D. i3 America Inc. Fiber Optics Agreement

Representatives from i3 America Inc. will be present to provide an overview of their contract, a draft of which is provided for the Board's review. In April, the Board and i3 America entered into a memorandum of understanding to investigate the feasibility of constructing a fiber optic broadband network in Gilberts. The proposed network would serve all residential and business addresses within the Village and would be known as Fibercity Gilberts. Staff will request the Board's direction on whether to continue working on the proposed agreement or to pursue other initiatives.

Call to Order/ Pledge of Allegiance

President Zirk called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He proceeded to lead those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call / Establish Quorum

Clerk Meadows called the roll. Roll call: Members present: Trustees Corbett, Clark, Mierisch, Farrell, Hacker and President Zirk. 1-absent: Trustee Zambetti. Others present: Administrator Keller, Attorney Tappendorf, Assistant to the Village Administrator Beith, Finance Director Blocker, Engineer Blecke, and Village Clerk Meadows. For members of the audience please see the attached list.

Public Comment

Mr. Keith Clayton of 1321 Maple, Wilmette, IL representing the Tyrrell Family and owners of the Tyrrell Family Farm adjacent to the south section of the Reimer property addressed the Board. He discussed his concerns with the Interstate Partnership's development and the proposed vacation of the Riemer Way Right- of- Way. If the Right-Of-Way was allowed to be vacated it would leave the Tyrrell family's farm north parcel land locked.

Mr. Clayton reported that he had met with Kane County Department of Transportation and they suggested that the location of the north access point be in the proximity of the intersection of Pierce Road and Tyrrell Road.

Trustee Zambetti arrived at 7:04 p.m.

Mr. Clayton reported that they have discussed this matter with their attorney and he strongly recommends that the Plat of Survey identifies the access road that replaces Riemer Way. President Zirk was sympathetic to Mr. Clayton's concerns. He also had questions on the access point. This matter will be discussed in the order it appears on the agenda. Mr. Clayton thanked the Board Members for their time.

Consent Agenda

- A. A Motion to approve Minutes from the September 18, 2012 Village Board Meeting**
- B. A Motion to approve Bills and Salaries as follows: General Fund \$50,608.74, Developer Donations and/or TIF \$2,620.00, Permit Pass Thrus \$1,415.00, Performance Bonds and Escrows \$3,816.69, Water Fund \$27,955.79, Payroll \$67,465.46**

President Zirk asked if there was any items the Board Members wished to remove from the consent agenda. There were no comments from the Board Members. **A Motion was made by Trustee Zambetti and seconded by Trustee Clark to approve the consent agenda as presented.** Roll call: Vote: 6-ayes: Trustees Corbett, Clark, Mierisch, Zambetti, Farrell and Hacker. 0-nays, 0-abstained. Motion carried.

Items for Discussion

Ordinance to rezone property to I-1 Industrial and approve a new planned unit development (PUD) and accompanying plans for Prairie Corporate Park

Administrator Keller provided the Board Members with a brief overview of the proposed development's concept plan. He noted that there have been only minor changes since the last presentation which was held prior to the Plan Commission Public Hearing. The Plan Commission recommended approval of the petition, subject to modifications to the permitted and special use lists to be attached to the PUD Ordinance.

Administrator Keller reported that staff is currently drafting additional documents which address the letter of credit, phasing, economic incentives (Industrial TIF District) among other supporting documentation.

President Zirk directed staff to distribute the additional documentation as it becomes available so the Board Members have adequate time to review the documentation.

A lengthy discussion ensued with respect to the Tyrrell Farm's northern access point. President Zirk expressed concern with not identifying the Tyrrell Family Farm's northern access point right-of-way on the plat. Mr. Ebacher (Interstate Partners representative) stated he had no intention to take any access point away from the Tyrrell property. It would not be in either of the properties best interest. He will meet with the Clayton's to discuss the location of the Tyrrell Farm's northern access point and together he believes they can mutually agree upon a location which allows for a little flexibility depending on the buildings final location.

Mr. Ebacher commented on the fact that he is extremely excited about the development. In his opinion the development will redefine the community.

Mr. Ebacher discussed the infrastructure improvements. He reported that Interstate Partners will be implementing a holistic approach in designing the development. Mr. Ebacher commented on the detail that would be focused on the berming, screening and accent features. He reported that the streets will be constructed of a newly developed innovative concrete material manufactured by Scurto a local Village business. In addition, the development will be connected to the Village water and sewer system.

Mr. Ebacher envisions a high end gas station/sundries retail user along Route 72. The commercial buildings would be an enhancement to the streetscape.

Trustee Corbett expressed concern with allowing a gas station in the close proximity of the existing gas station. Mr. Ebacher responded that he had completed a market analysis and the Village is currently under served. He noted that currently there is no location in the Village that provides a service in which the consumer can purchase gas, a quick meal and sundry items. In addition, a retail center offering these types of services and products would generate sales tax revenues for the Village.

Trustee Clark expressed concern with developing the industrial sites first. He would prefer the retail be developed in phase 1. Mr. Ebacher understood Trustee Clark's rationale for developing the retail first. However, the business plan is to develop the first phase of the industrial park. He anticipates the build-out for the entire project to take about seven years.

Trustee Mierisch reported that during the Plan Commission's Public Hearing discussion she was uncomfortable with the request to increase the site coverage limit percentages from 45% to 85%. President Zirk replied that when the site coverage limit percentages were originally established the development was slated to have septic fields which require a large percentage of the property to be dedicated to the septic fields. However, the site is now going to be connected to the Village water and sewer systems so the site coverage limit can be increased to reflect that change. In addition, Interstate Partners will be purchasing 19.9 detentions credits to provide for adequate stormwater storage. Mr. Ebacher elaborated on the offsite stormwater storage. He stated that he prefers offsite storage over ground water run-off. He reported that this practice preserves the road and sidewalks and eliminates mosquito breeding ponds.

Trustee Mierisch inquired about the back-up SSA. She asked if this was one of the documents that staff would be supplying at a later date. Administrator Keller responded yes the back-up SSA would be drafted during the Final Plat process.

There was some discussion with respect to the formula that would be used in the back-up SSA for assessing the value of the property. Attorney Tappendorf and Engineer Blecke will discuss which formula would be appropriate.

Trustee Mierisch recommended some of the uses noted on the lists of allowed, prohibit and special use be more defined. Administrator Keller agreed. Administrator Keller will discuss the definitions of the various lists of uses with Mr. Ebacher.

Trustee Mierisch asked if the allowable, prohibited, and special uses for the proposed development mirror the uses in the draft UDO. Administrator Keller replied yes. The draft UDO has very few amendments to the original zoning code uses either allowable, prohibited or special uses. Staff will email Board Members a copy of the black line draft UDO.

Trustee Mierisch questioned if the comments provided by Rutland Dundee Fire Department are in the process of being addressed. Mr. Ebacher replied yes, their recommendations are easy fixes.

Trustee Mierisch stated that she wanted to ensure that the design standards and any other conditions are included as exhibits in the Ordinance to avoid a situation that arose in the past. Administrator Keller confirmed that the design standards and other stipulations will be memorialized and recorded.

Trustee Zambetti reported that he was pleased to have Interstate Partner develop in the community. He hopes to build a strong working partnership. Trustee Zambetti was also pleased that Interstate Partner's adopts CCR's to govern their developments.

Trustee Farrell inquired if Interstate Partners had a mass grading timeline. Mr. Ebacher replied that they will wait until the petitions have gone through the process and have been approved. However, upon approval they will begin grading the property and planting vegetation in the areas to be developed in the later phases. Mr. Ebacher reported that he prefers their development sites appear manicured. To achieve the manicured appearance they plant winter wheat or soy beans. He anticipates planting could begin as early as fall of this year or spring 2013.

Trustee Farrell questioned if Interstate Partners were to fail would the development design standards remain in place. Administrator Keller responded yes, the design standards will be tied to the land.

Trustee Hacker commented on the current condition of the site. He asked Mr. Ebacher if he could anticipate when they would be removing the rock piles and overgrown vegetation. Mr. Ebacher anticipates the north section of the property will be graded late 2012 and the remaining portion of the property graded within 24 to 48 months.

Trustee Hacker questioned the location of the industrial buildings loading docks. Mr. Ebacher replied that the loading docks will be constructed in a way that they will be hidden from sight.

Trustee Hacker asked Mr. Ebacher if he could provide an example on what the retail buildings would resemble. Mr. Ebacher replied, the buildings would be similar to the Grove development located in Elgin.

Trustee Clark noted that a portion of the property will be non-forming if and when the property is rezoned. Mr. Ebacher is aware of the parcel Trustee Clark is referring to. However, currently the equipment is kept in an orderly fashion and will not hinder his grading work.

President Zirk asked staff what the proposed under lying zoning for the development was. Administrator Keller reported that the under lying zoning is slated to be I-1 (Industrial). The reason for the I-1 under lying zoning is due to the proposed establishment of the Industrial TIF district.

President Zirk listed the documents that are still forthcoming as follows:

- Back-up SSA
- The preliminary plat depicting the Tyrrell Family Farm north access point
- CCR's
- Design Standards

President Zirk asked the Board Members to inform Administrator Keller of any concerns they may have with the proposed development so he may incorporate their comments into the appropriate documentation.

There was some discussion with respect to balancing the site.

President Zirk inquired if the proposed development would be requesting any operational deviations such as users emitting any types of odors, excessive noise, and/or conducting unusual activities. Administrator Keller replied that they were not requesting any deviations from the zoning code.

President Zirk stated various retail businesses that would have a positive impact on the community. He noted that although banks don't generate sales tax he thought a bank would be a nice convenience for the residents.

Administrator Keller will work with Attorney Tappendorf, Engineer Blecke and Mr. Ebacher to complete the required documentation. This matter will be placed on the next Village Board Meeting Agenda.

Staff Reports

Administrator Keller reported that at the October 16th Board meeting he will invite a representative from PGAV Urban Consulting to present an overview on establishing TIF Districts.

Board of Trustee Reports

Trustee Hacker expressed concerns with the informative Park Referendum newsletter insert. He felt there should have been more information with respect to the option of participating in the Dundee Park District. A lengthy discussion ensued. After the discussion ended Trustee Hacker withdrew his concern.

President's Report

President Zirk directed staff to follow-up with the Rutland Dundee Fire Department and Chief Williams on their recommendation regarding the CERT's organization.

Adjournment

There being no further public business to discuss, a motion was made by Trustee Clark and seconded by Trustee Zambetti to adjourn from the public meeting at 9:47 p.m. Roll call: Vote: 6 ayes by unanimous voice vote. 0-nays, 0-abstained. Motion carried.

In February of this year the position of Police Administrative Assistant was eliminated for economic and operational reasons. At that time we discussed the option of opening up 2 part time positions sometime in the future. I am in the process of reviewing applications for an additional certified part-time patrol officer. This position will be funded by the current part time salary budget.

I request a second part time position to help fulfill the department's stated objectives of providing community policing programs and to reduce the strain on current job tasks and assignments that are essential to the operation of the department but are not directly mission related. These tasks include routine non law enforcement related activities such as shuttling squads for repairs, delivering records to the court clerk's office, providing direct support to patrol officers on the scene of an incident, mail delivery, fingerprinting and other such tasks.

This new position of Community Service Officer will be a non-sworn civilian position. I have attached a draft of the job description for your review. I am requesting an adjustment to the part time salary budget be made mid-year for this 16 hour per week position.

Purpose of Classification

The purpose of this position is to assist Police Department personnel in the performance of their duties of a non-hazardous nature, including report writing, animal control, traffic control and other operations as assigned. This position enables Sworn Officers to concentrate on more complex aspects of Law Enforcement by handling time consuming and routine tasks otherwise performed by Sworn Officers. The Community Service Officer shall promote police/community partnerships to address the causes of criminal activity, community disorder, community concerns and other community issues.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

The following duties are normal for this classification. These are not to be construed as exclusive or all-inclusive. Other duties may be required and assigned.

1. Initiate, develop, implement and follow through with solutions to specific problems that are identified or brought to the Police Department's attention.
2. Provide personalized and decentralized police service to the Village.
3. Provides effective and efficient customer services and promotes and maintains responsive community relations.
4. Develop collaborative relationships among individuals and organizations necessary to jointly solve crime problems. Actively promote and enlist citizen involvement in combating crime and eliminating public disorder.
5. Write non-hazardous reports involving thefts, malicious mischief, property-damage-only motor vehicle incidents, either on-station, public roadway or private property.
6. Prepare written reports.
7. Investigate abandoned autos and animal violations.
8. Enforce parking and other municipal regulations and issues citations.
9. Assist in traffic control; assists motorists as needed.

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10. Pick up and/or trap stray/wild animals, transports animal for disposition at end of impoundment; make door-to-door contact with known or suspected animal owners for animal licenses.
11. Check security of reported vacant homes and business establishments.
12. Transports citations, bond monies, subpoenaed records, evidence, etc. as required.
13. Relay motor vehicles back and forth from Police Department for repairs/service.
14. Serves in a variety of administrative roles as assigned by the Chief or designee, such as conducting special projects, coordinating DARE, CERTs, neighborhood watch and other programs, performing other related work; actively promotes crime-prevention strategies and methods.
15. Complies with all personal safety rules and regulations, both written and verbal, as instructed by the Chief.
16. Appear in court as required.
17. Coordinates efforts with those of other members of the department so that teamwork may ensure continuity of purpose and achievement of police objectives. Communicates to superiors and to fellow officers all information obtained in the field which is pertinent to the achievement of police objectives. Cooperates and coordinates with other law-enforcement agencies, correctional institutions, and the courts.
18. Responds punctually to all assignments.
19. Assists all citizens who request assistance or information.
20. Accomplishes other general duties as they are assigned or become necessary.
29. Wears traffic safety clothing and equipment as prescribed by the Department General Order and/or the Police Chief.
30. Reports circumstances and situations that are deemed hazardous or detrimental to the public or Village employees in a timely manner.

Additional Tasks and Responsibilities

The following duties are normal for this classification. These are not to be construed as exclusive or all-inclusive. Other duties may be required and assigned.

1. Implements crime prevention and other community programs.
2. Performs routine clerical, data entry, filing, and copying as assigned.
3. Act as the Evidence/Property Custodian, Crime/Traffic Analyst, or other duties as assigned.

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4. Performs related work as required.

Minimum Education, Training and Experience Required to Perform Essential Job Functions

1. Graduation from high school (or GED) required, with
2. Knowledge of modern police practices and methods
3. Knowledge of department procedures, rules and regulations
4. Knowledge of current applicable federal, state and local laws and ordinances.
5. Knowledge of the street layout and geography of the Village and immediately surrounding area
6. Ability to operate a personal computer and software such as word processing and spreadsheet programs
7. Skill in the use of the following tools and equipment: police car, police radio, radar gun, handcuffs and other personal restraint devices, pagers and first aid equipment.
8. Possession of a valid Illinois motor vehicle license required.
9. Some knowledge of the philosophy, objectives, and methods of counseling, mediation, and community organizing; some knowledge of the fundamental principles of adolescent and adult psychology.

Physical and Mental Abilities Required to Perform Essential Job Functions

Language Ability and Interpersonal Communication

1. Ability to decide the time, place, and sequence of operations within an organizational framework, and to oversee their execution. Ability to analyze and categorize data and information using established criteria, to determine consequences and identify and select alternatives.
2. Ability to establish effective working relationships with juveniles, parents, school officials, fellow workers, and the public. Ability to advise and interpret regarding the application of policies, procedures, and standards to specific situations.
3. Ability to utilize a wide variety of advisory descriptive and inferential data and information such as legal briefs, organizational analysis, invoices, financial reports, budgets, bid specifications, request for proposals, grant applications, crime statistics and trends, job applications, personnel policies, union contracts, grievances, statutes, case law, ordinances, regulations, emergency preparedness plans, professional journals, non-routine correspondence, department activity reports, and police reports.

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4. Ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing, in person and by telephone, email, fax or other means, with Village personnel, elected officials, vendors, consultants, public agencies, and the public.

Mathematical Ability

1. Ability to calculate percentages, fractions, decimals, volumes, ratios, present value and spatial relationships. Ability to interpret basic descriptive statistical reports.

Judgment and Situational Reasoning Ability

1. Ability to apply functional reasoning in synthesizing information and functions, and ability to influence others in activities such as leading, controlling, and directing.
2. Ability to exercise the judgment, decisiveness, and creativity required in critical and/or unexpected situations involving moderate to extreme risk to the public and/or the organization.

Physical Requirements

1. Ability to operate, maneuver, and/or steer equipment and machinery requiring simple but continuous adjustments, such as motor vehicles, computer terminal, emergency communication equipment, firearms, restraint devices, fax machine, and calculator/adding machine.

CONSTRUCTION OF FIBERCITY GILBERTS
AN AGREEMENT between
VILLAGE OF GILBERTS, ILLINOIS and i3 AMERICA INC.

On April 10th, 2012 the Village of Gilberts, Illinois and i3 America Inc. entered into a Memorandum of Understanding in which each party agreed to work together to investigate the feasibility of constructing a fiber optic broadband network to serve all residential and business addresses within the Village to be known as Fibercity Gilberts. The building of Fibercity Gilberts is based upon specialized fiber optic cable technology i3 developed, which allows for placement of the cable in the waste water system. Treating the waste water system as a pre-placed conduit, allows for a significant reduction in installation costs, making the construction and operation of the network economically feasible.

i3 America will be the owner and operator of Fibercity Gilberts. Operating as an open system network, Fibercity Gilberts will be constructed to pass every residential and business address in the village and will be available to any content provider. This open systems business model allows multiple content providers to share the cost of a single network, thus decreasing the infrastructure cost necessary to deliver content to a location in the village.

The term of the Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and expire ten (10) years from the date hereof. This Agreement may be renewed upon the mutual assent of the parties for two (2) successive five (5) year terms, on the same terms and conditions, provided that there is no uncured event of default at the time of renewal. In the event of termination of this Agreement or upon the expiration of this Agreement, the parties will negotiate a commercially reasonable operating agreement for the continued use of the existing System, which could involve ownership and operation of the System by Village or a third party and at the same time compensate Grantee.

Programming on the network will typically come in one of three forms, video, voice communication, and internet service. Each video content provider using the Fibercity Gilberts network will be subject to a franchise agreement with the Village of Gilberts. Each content provider delivering internet and voice services will be subject to the Simplified Municipal Telecommunications Tax Act.

Section 12-1F-4 of the Village Code expressly requires any person to whom "the right is granted, by lease, license, franchise or other manner, to use and occupy village property for the installation of telecommunications facilities," to pay compensation as shall be fixed by the Village. This provision may also be relied upon to require the payment of rent for placement of the fiber in the sanitary sewer system.

As part of this agreement Fibercity Gilberts will compensate the Village by:

1) Providing two strands of fiber to each municipal location at no cost to the following locations:

- Village Hall 87 Galligan Road
- Police Department 86 Railroad Street
- Public Works/Finance Dept. 73 Industrial Drive
- Waste Water Treatment Plant 281 Raymond Drive
- Fresh Water Treatment Plant 320 Raymond Drive
- North Water Tower 19N056 Galligan Road
- Middle Water Tower 598 Sleeping Bear Lane
- South Water Tower 16 Tyrrell Road
- Rutland Fire Protection District 11 East Higgins Road
- Gilberts Elementary School 729 Paperbark Lane
- Stubs for additional community anchor institutions

2) Payment of a onetime fee based on the linear footage of cable installed in the waste water system. This calculation is still subject to negotiation, but i3 has suggested 10 cents per foot, stating the typical network installation consists of 260,000 cable feet. Using these numbers the fee would be \$26,000.

In addition, i3 America, as a developer, will be subject to Village Code and all the related fees and escrows typically placed on every development in the Village. Scott Bradshaw of i3 America will present details of Fibercity Gilberts and be available to answer questions.

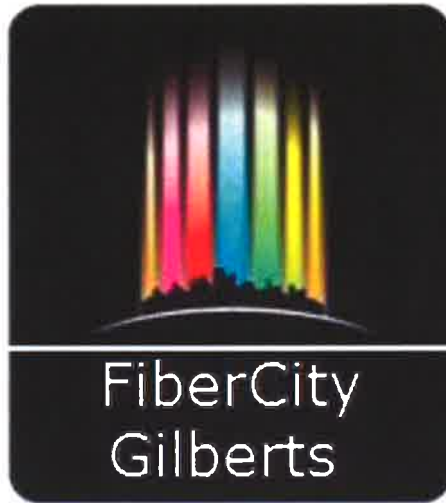

AGREEMENT

This Agreement (hereinafter, the "Agreement") is made between the Village of Gilberts, Illinois (hereinafter, the "**Village**" or "Authority") and FiberCity Gilberts LLC (hereinafter, the "Grantee").

The Village desires to enter into this Agreement with the Grantee for the right to construct, maintain and operate the System, on the terms and subject to the conditions set forth herein.

SECTION 1: Definition of Terms

1.1 Terms.

For the purpose of this Agreement, the following terms, phrases, words, and abbreviations shall have the meanings ascribed to them below.

"Act" means any applicable statute, law, ordinance including Village of Gilberts Code by which the Village has authorized the execution, delivery and performance of this Agreement.

"Agreement" means the initial authorization, or renewal thereof, issued by the Village President, whether such authorization is designated as a, registration, permit, license, resolution, contract, certificate, ordinance or otherwise, which authorizes construction and operation of the System. Agreement also includes any amendments or modifications hereto.

"Authority" means the Village of Gilberts, Illinois including its Board of Trustees, Commissions and Committees or the lawful successor, transferee, designee, or assignee thereof.



"Effective Date" shall be the date of execution of the Agreement by the Village and Grantee.

"Facilities" means the PoP at 73 Industrial Drive, Gilberts, Illinois, 60136, which is the building and related electronic and fiber facilities [which are designated and agreed upon and set forth on Exhibit 1] are located in the Village from which the fiber optic cables will be deployed to a Premise Wall and attached to a suitable enclosure.

"Boundary" means the present legal boundaries of the Village as of the Effective Date, and shall also include any additions thereto or subtractions thereof, by annexation or other legal means.

"Grantee" shall have the meaning set forth in the preamble hereof

"Law" shall include all federal, state or local laws, regulations or rules, and any other action by an authorized entity or person that has the effect of law.

"ONT" means Optical Network Terminal mounted on the Premise Wall.

"Order of Demand" a measure of subscribing premise's that express a desire to receive services from a Service Provider over the System.

"Person" means any natural person or any association, firm, partnership, joint venture, corporation, or other legally recognized entity, whether for-profit or not-for profit, but shall not mean the Village.

"PoP" means point of presence, the physical central location of the Facilities.

"Premise Wall" means the wall of the business or residence to which the fiber optic cable will terminate, which is part of the System.

"Public Way" shall mean the Right(s) of Way, as such term is defined in Section 9-8C-2 of the Village Code.

"Service Provider" means a person who will provide telecommunications, information, or video programming services at retail over the System to any subscribing premise that requests all or a part of such services.

"System" means a fiber optic network that will allow Service Providers to deliver telecommunications, information, or video programming services to subscribing premises, with the fiber optic cable to be laid from the PoP through the Public Way and to the Premise



Wall. The Grantee will use its reasonable commercial efforts to contract System access to one or many Service Providers who have an intention to deliver subscriber services. So long as the Grantee does not provide telecommunications, information, or video programming services, it is not a Service Provider.



SECTION2: Grant of Authority

2.1. Grant of Agreement.

2.1.1 The Authority hereby grants to the Grantee under the Act a non-exclusive Agreement, which authorizes the Grantee to construct, maintain and operate the System among, upon, across, above, over, under, or in any manner connected with Public Ways within the Boundary, and for that purpose to erect, install, construct, repair, replace, reconstruct, maintain, operate or retain in, on, over, under, upon, across, or along any Public Way and all extensions thereof and additions thereto: wires, cables, ducts, conduits, vaults, manholes, pedestals, appliances, attachments, and other related property or equipment as may be necessary or appurtenant to the System.

2.1.2 The Authority hereby grants to the Grantee an exclusive Agreement which authorizes Grantee to construct, maintain and operate the portions of the System within and through such wastewater assets, including sanitary and storm systems, as are necessary and convenient for the operation of the System. For the purpose of this Agreement, the exclusivity granted herein is solely with respect to installation of the System in the wastewater assets of the Authority. The portions of the System which may be erected, installed, constructed, repaired, replaced and maintained in the wastewater assets shall be subject to the exclusive and sole discretion of the Authority.

2.1.3 In consideration of the authority granted herein, Grantee will enter into agreements with one or more Service Providers for purposes of selling telecommunications, information, or video programming services at retail using the System. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to grant any authority to a Service Provider with respect to the sale at retail of any telecommunications, information, or video programming services.

2.2. Term of Agreement.

The term of the Agreement hereunder shall commence on the Effective Date and expire twenty (20) years from the date hereof. This Agreement may be renewed upon the mutual assent of the parties for two (2) successive five (5) year terms, on the same terms and conditions, provided that there is no uncured event of default at the time of renewal.

2.3 Fees, Expenses and other Charges.

Except as expressly set forth herein, each party shall bear and be responsible for all of its own costs, fees and expenses incurred in executing and performing under this Agreement.



2.3.1 Any Service Provider that delivers content over the System to a subscribing premise will pay a fee as defined in Village of Gilberts Code Title 12 Telecommunications and Wireless Service.

2.3.2 In consideration for the exclusive right to occupy the waste water assets, Grantee shall provide the Authority with two strands of dark fiber to each address listed in Exhibit 2 with no limitation to the content carried on that fiber.

2.3.3 In consideration for the exclusive right to occupy the waste water assets, Grantee shall provide the Authority with a onetime fee of zero cents (\$.0) per foot of waste water asset utilized

2.4. Reservation of Authority.

Nothing in this Agreement shall (A) abrogate the right of the Authority to perform any public works or public improvements of any description, (B) be construed as a waiver of any codes or ordinances of general applicability promulgated by the Authority, (C) be construed as a waiver or release of the rights of the Authority in and to the Public Ways, or (D) be a waiver or result in the diminution of the Authority's police power.

SECTION 3: The System

3.1. Permits and General Obligations.

The Grantee shall abide by the lawful rules and regulations of the Village, including but not limited to Title 9, Chapter 8, Article C, "Construction of Facilities in Public Rights of Way." Construction, installation, and maintenance of the System shall be performed in a safe, thorough, workmanlike and reliable manner using materials of good and durable quality. All transmission and distribution structures, and equipment installed by Grantee for use in the System in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be located so as to minimize the interference with the proper use of the wastewater assets and Public Ways and the rights and reasonable convenience of property owners who own property that adjoins any such Public Way.

3.2 Conditions on Street Occupancy.

3.2.1. Relocation at request of the Authority. The Grantee shall comply with Section 9-8C-12 of the Code. Grantee shall also not be responsible for the cost associated with relocating the System to accommodate a private development project or the construction of a new school, hospital or other public entity that affects the Public Way, but



the Grantee shall remain responsible for costs associated with relocating the System to accommodate all other public projects of the Village affecting the Public Way. The Village shall use its reasonable efforts to reduce or keep Grantee's costs of compliance with this provision to a minimum, provided the Village's costs take precedence over Grantee's costs in planning future public improvements.

3.2.2. Relocation at request of Third Party. The Grantee shall, upon reasonable prior written request of any Person holding a permit issued by the Authority to move any structure, temporarily move its fiber optic cables to permit the moving of such structure; provided (i) the Grantee may impose a reasonable charge on any Person for the movement of its fiber optic cables, and such charge may be required to be paid in advance of the movement of its fiber optic cables; and (ii) the Grantee is given not less than fifteen (15) business days advance written notice to arrange for such temporary relocation.

3.2.3. Restoration of Public Ways. Grantee shall comply with Section 9-8C-13.

3.2.4. Safety Requirements. The Grantee shall, at its own cost and expense, undertake all necessary and commercially reasonable efforts to maintain its work sites and the System, consistent with industry practices, in a safe manner and in normal order and repair in order to prevent failures and accidents that may cause damage, injuries or nuisances. All work undertaken on the System shall be performed in substantial compliance with applicable federal, state, and local regulations. The System shall not unreasonably endanger or interfere with the safety of Persons or property in the Boundary. The Grantee shall maintain a labor force sufficient to ensure compliance with this provision.

SECTION 4: Construction and Facilities

4.1. Construction of System.

The parties agree the Grantee will construct a System that passes every premise within Exhibit 2 through to Exhibit 4 and provision fiber to serve future development within Exhibit 5 and Exhibit 6. Construction of the i3 FOCUS fiber cable will be installed within the waste water and connection to the locations defined in Exhibit 2, by no later than July 31, 2013 and connections from the i3 FOCUS fiber cable to the premise wall will be built out according to Order of Demand.



4.2 *Designation and Construction of Facilities.*

4.2.1 Facilities Access. The Grantee shall during the term and all renewal terms hereof have access to and rights to use the Facilities, subject to applicable law, at its own cost and expense. The Facilities will house the equipment necessary in Grantee's judgment to enable the System to operate.

4.2.2 Construction Techniques. Except to the extent approved by the Department of Public Works, Grantee shall comply with Section 9-8C-10. Authority agrees to work cooperatively with Grantee in reviewing all potential construction methods.

4.2.3 PoP location and Material Storage. Village will make space available to the Grantee for the installation of Grantee's PoP as set forth in Exhibit A, located behind the Village of Gilberts Public Works building at 73 Industrial Drive, Gilberts, Illinois, 60136. The design of the PoP will allow 24/7 access without Village of Gilberts personnel to be present to perform installation, operation, maintenance, replacement, repair, or other activities necessary to maintain the network in operating condition. Village will assist contractor for the housing of materials to build the System.

4.3 *Subscriber Connections*

When a Service Provider confirms a subscriber has entered into an agreement to accept services over the System a fiber will be terminated at the subscriber Premise Wall, via a drop from the System and in a manner to be determined by the Grantee. The location and the method of the drop to the premise wall will vary depending on the circumstances of the subscriber location.

The following will apply to the connection between the System and the Premise Wall of each subscriber:

- i) Village will assist Grantee in securing private property easement access rights, when necessary, to connect the System from the subscriber property boundary to the Premise Wall.
- ii) Where possible, Grantee shall install subscriber drops underground.



SECTION 5: Oversight and Regulation by Authority

5.1 Oversight of Agreement.

Grantee agrees to comply with Title 9, Chapter 8, Article C. To the extent such ordinance clearly conflicts with the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail, except where such conflict arises from the Authority's lawful exercise of its police powers. Nothing in this Section 5.1 shall be construed to limit the Authority's ability to enforce the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

5.2 Compliance with Applicable Laws.

Subject to Section 5.1 of this Agreement, the Grantee shall, at all times during the life of this Agreement, be subject to and comply in all material respects with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, rules regulations and policies, as now or hereafter adopted or amended.

5.3 Confidentiality and Proprietary Information.

5.3.1. Treatment of Confidential and Proprietary Information. Though all information is subject to Illinois Freedom of Information Act, the Village represents that it will use all reasonable efforts to claim available exemptions under state Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) law, and will notify Grantee if a FIOA request is received in connection with that proprietary information. All materials that Grantee believes are proprietary will be labeled "Proprietary, privileged and confidential". The Village of Gilberts will work with Fibercity Gilberts LLC to manage intellectual content. In the event of an appeal of a denial based upon i3's assertion of confidentiality, i3 agrees to indemnify and defend the Village in that appeal.

5.4 Transfer of Agreement.

Neither the Grantee nor any other Person may transfer the System or this Agreement



without the prior written consent of the Authority. Consent shall be required, however, for:

(i) a transfer in trust, by mortgage, hypothecation, or by assignment of any rights, title, or interest of the Grantee in this Agreement or the System in order to secure indebtedness, provided that the security holder shall execute an agreement reasonably acceptable to the Village that it shall operate the System for the term of this Agreement in the event it enforces any or all of its rights relative to Grantee, or

(ii) a transfer to an entity directly or indirectly owned or controlled by or controlling or under common control with Grantee.



SECTION 6: Insurance and Indemnity

6.1. Insurance; Indemnification.

6.2.1 Throughout the term of this Agreement, the Grantee shall, at its own cost and expense, Comply with Section 9-8C-5 of the Village Code.

6.2.2 The Authority shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Grantee, its members, directors, officers, employees, and agents and its and their respective affiliates, successors and assigns from and against any liability or claims resulting from property damage or bodily injury (including accidental death), which arise solely out of any act or omission for which the Village may be held liable under the Laws of the State of Illinois, provided that the Grantee shall give Authority written notice of its obligation to indemnify the Grantee as soon as reasonably possible or practical to do so following the proper and legal receipt of a claim or action pursuant to this Section 6.2 and in any case no longer than ten (10) days after receipt. If the Grantee determines that it is necessary for it to employ separate counsel, the costs for such separate counsel shall be the responsibility of the Grantee.

SECTION 7: System Description and Service

7.1. System Description and Service.

The System shall be designed in a manner using fiber optic cable using the Public Way emanating from the PoP to the Public Way and from there to the Premises Wall. The network shall conform to the Village of Gilberts Municipal Code including Title 12, Telecommunications and Wireless Services, Section 9-8C-4 Permit requirements, and Section 2-4-2 Performance Bond. The parties will collaborate on the System design from the Facilities, through the Public Way and to the Premise Wall.

7.2 Project Obligations.

7.2.1 Obligations of Village In addition to all other obligations mentioned elsewhere in this Agreement, Village will have the following obligations:



(a) Provide a single point of contact (“SPOC”) for Grantee, which SPOC will be responsible for addressing all administrative issues related to the System, providing coordination across Village departments and serving as a communications and troubleshooting resource for Grantee. Nothing herein shall be construed as a delegation of legislative authority to the SPOC.

(b) Offer the full cooperation of all Village departments with respect to relevant issues on the System. Such cooperation will be supervised by the SPOC

(c) Participate in regular status meetings for the coordination of all matters related to the System.

(d) Provide quick, diligent review of all applications for permits, including permits or other necessary items for construction work on the System within Village Public Way.

(e) Cooperate with Grantee on all publicity and public relations for the System.

7.2.2 Obligations of the Grantee In addition to all other obligations mentioned elsewhere in this Agreement, the Grantee will have the following obligations:

(a) Work closely with the SPOC of the Village and relevant Village departments with respect to the construction of the System.

(b) Comply with all requirements of Village for permit and Public Way use applications, including but not limited to Title 9, Article 8C of the Village Code.

(c) Build the System to pass every premise as listed in Exhibit 2 through to Exhibit 4 and provision fiber to serve future development within Exhibit 5 and Exhibit 6. The parties will collaborate on the System design to serve Exhibit 5 and Exhibit 6;

(i) Distribution of content within a single premise is the responsibility of the premise owner. That owner may contract with a Service Provider to, at additional cost to the premise owner, install internal network components to deliver content services as directed by the premise owner.

(ii) Apartment buildings, townhouse, condominiums and similar type buildings shall have an ONT for each separately addressed living space within the structure.

(iii) Any premise that requires connection to the System that is not listed in Exhibit 2 through to Exhibit 4 will be negotiated outside this Agreement and treated as an addendum to the Agreement.



SECTION 8: Enforcement and Termination of Agreement

8.1. Notice of Violation or Default.

In the event the Authority believes that ~~the~~ Grantee has not complied with the material terms of this Agreement, the Authority shall promptly notify the Grantee in writing with specific details regarding the exact nature of the alleged noncompliance or default.

8.2. Grantee's Right to Cure or Respond.

The Grantee shall have thirty (30) days from the receipt of the Authority's notice described in Section 8.1, above:

(a) to respond to the Authority, contesting the assertion of noncompliance or default, or

(b) to cure such default, or

(c) in the event that, by nature of the default, such default cannot be cured within the thirty (30) day period, initiate reasonable steps to remedy such default, notify the Village of Gilberts of the steps being taken, the projected date that they will be completed, and continue to exercise diligence in executing the cure to completion. Such date shall be accepted as an extension of time to cure upon the written consent of the Village of Gilberts.

8.3. Default.

In the event ~~the~~ Grantee fails to respond to the Authority's notice described in Section 8.1, above, or in the event that the alleged default is not remedied within said thirty (30) days or the later date agreed upon pursuant to Section 8.2 above, the Grantee shall be deemed in default and subject to the remedies herein described and otherwise available at law and in equity.

8.4. Enforcement.

Subject to applicable federal and state law and the preceding procedural steps, in the event the Authority **determines** that the Grantee is in default of any provision of **the Agreement**, the Authority may:



8.4.1. Seek specific performance of any provision which reasonably lends itself to such remedy, as an alternative to damages or seek other equitable relief; or

8.4.2. In the case of a substantial default of a material provision of the Agreement, declare the Agreement to be revoked in accordance with the following:

- (i) The Authority shall give written notice to the Grantee of its intent to revoke the Agreement on the basis of a material default or a pattern of noncompliance by the Grantee. The notice shall set forth with specificity the exact nature of the material default or pattern of noncompliance. The Grantee shall have thirty (30) days from the receipt of such notice to object in writing and to state its reasons with specificity for such objection. In the event the Authority has not received a satisfactory response from the Grantee, it may then seek termination of this Agreement. In the event the Authority seeks termination of this Agreement, the Authority shall schedule a public hearing to be held at the next regularly scheduled public meeting of the Authority for the purpose of allowing the Authority the opportunity to present its basis of termination and to allow the Grantee the opportunity to respond. The Authority shall cause to be served upon the Grantee, at least ten (10) days prior to such public meeting, a written notice specifying the time and place of such hearing and stating its intent to request termination of the Agreement.
- (ii) At the designated hearing, the Authority shall give the Grantee an opportunity to state its position on the matter, including the presentation of documents or other materials or speakers necessary to present its position, after which, the Authority shall determine whether or not the Agreement shall be revoked. The public meeting shall be on the record and a written transcript shall be made available to the Grantee, at the Grantee's sole expense, within ten (10) business days. The decision of the Authority shall be in writing and shall be delivered to the Grantee in the manner set forth in Section 11.2, herein and shall be considered a final action of the Authority on the matter of revocation.

8.4.3 The Authority may, at its sole discretion, take any lawful action that it deems appropriate to enforce its rights under the Agreement in lieu of revocation.



8.6 Authority Breach or Default.

In the event the Grantee believes that the Authority has not complied with the material terms of this Agreement, it shall promptly notify the Authority in writing with specific details regarding the exact nature of the alleged noncompliance or default. The other terms and provisions of section 8.2, 8.3 and 8.4.1 hereof shall then apply except simply reversing Authority with Grantee and Grantee with Authority. The sole remedy available to Grantee for a breach or default by the Authority shall be specific performance or other available equitable relief. In no case shall the Authority be liable to Grantee for any special, indirect, incidental, consequential, or exemplary damages, including, without limitation, any damages resulting from loss of use, loss of data, interruption of business activities, or failure to realize profits arising out of the operation of the System, regardless of whether a claim is based on a theory of contract or tort, including negligence and strict liability. It is understood and agreed that any breach of the exclusivity provisions and term, not in limitation of other provisions set forth herein, are material.

8.7 Limitation on Liability.

EXCEPT FOR A PARTY'S INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS, IN NO EVENT WILL EITHER PARTY BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER PARTY FOR ANY INDIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, RELIANCE, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES OF ANY KIND OR NATURE WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ANY LOST PROFITS, LOST REVENUES, LOST SAVINGS, OR HARM TO BUSINESS. EACH PARTY HEREBY RELEASES THE OTHER PARTY, ITS SUBSIDIARIES AND AFFILIATES, AND THEIR RESPECTIVE TRUSTEES, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, MANAGERS, EMPLOYEES, AND AGENTS, FROM ANY SUCH CLAIM.

8.9 Transition upon Termination

In the event of termination of this Agreement upon the expiration of this Agreement at the end of the term (and any renewal term), the parties will negotiate a commercially reasonable operating agreement for the continued use of the existing System, which could involve ownership and operation of the System by Village or a third party and at the same time compensate Grantee.

In the event of termination of this Agreement upon the expiration of this Agreement at the end of the term (and any renewal term), the Village will have the right and option to purchase the fiber network from Grantee at any time prior to such a termination. Village shall



exercise its aforesaid option by giving Grantee written notice of Village's election to exercise its option no less than 120 days prior to the end of the then existing term. The Village's exercise notice shall specify the date, time and place of closing, which date (the "Closing") shall be neither earlier than 30 days nor later than 150 days after the notice given. In connection with this option, the parties further agree as follows:

- (a) The purchase price to be paid by Village, or its designee, for the System (the **"Purchase Price"**) shall be the **"Fair Market Value of the System"**, which shall be mutually agreed upon Village and Grantee; however, if the parties do not agree as to the Fair Market Value of the System within thirty (30) days after the Exercise Date, then each party shall choose a **"Qualified Expert"** who shall make such determination of the Fair Market value of the System as of the Exercise Date and submit the same to the other party (together with the information forming the basis for such determination) within seventy five (75) days after the Exercise Date (with each party paying the fee for its own Qualified Expert), but if the two Qualified Experts do not agree as to the Fair Market Value for the System within fifteen (15) days thereafter, the two Qualified Experts shall promptly jointly select a third Qualified Expert. Within 30 days after his or her appointment, the third Qualified Expert shall select one of the two initially submitted appraisals as the Fair Market Value of the System and such selection shall be binding upon the parties.
- (b) For purposes hereof, the term **"Qualified Expert"** shall mean an independent unaffiliated third party with expertise and knowledge about fiber networks of this kind and the market value of the same, taking into account the technology, infrastructure, depreciation, current liabilities, the parties' previous contributions to the System, customer base, service speeds and other relevant market factors. The fee of the third Qualified Expert, if any, shall be paid by the party whose determination of the Fair Market Value of the System is ~~not~~ selected by the third Qualified Expert. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Village may terminate the Agreement without giving 180 days notice if Grantee is in default and Village does not elect to exercise its option to purchase the System hereunder.



SECTION 9: Miscellaneous Provisions

9.1 Force Majeure

Neither party shall not be held in default under, or in breach or noncompliance with, the provisions of this Agreement, nor suffer any enforcement or penalty relating to noncompliance or default (including termination, cancellation or revocation of the Agreement), where such noncompliance or alleged defaults occurred or were caused by strike, riot, war, earthquake, flood, unusually severe rain or snow storm, hurricane, tornado or other catastrophic act of nature, labor disputes, failure of utility service necessary to construct or maintain the System, governmental, administrative or judicial order or regulation or other event that is reasonably beyond the Grantee's ability to anticipate or control. This provision also covers work delays caused by waiting for utility providers to service or monitor their own utility infrastructure on which the Grantee's fiber optic cable and/or equipment may be deployed, as well as unavailability of materials and/or qualified labor to perform the work necessary. To claim a force majeure event the affected party shall send notice to the other party within three (3) business days of the onset of the cause giving rise to the force majeure event. Thereafter, the delay granted by the force majeure shall only be for so long as the cause of the event continues. Either party may give notice to the other of the abatement of the cause giving rise to the force majeure event.

9.2 Notice

All notices shall be in writing and shall be sufficiently given and served upon the other party by hand delivery, overnight mail, or by facsimile with confirmed transmission and addressed as follows:

Notices shall be deemed received the same day with delivery upon hand delivery, and the next business day with delivery upon overnight mail, electronic mail, or by facsimile.

9.3. Entire Agreement

This Agreement, including all Exhibits, embodies the entire understanding and agreement of the Authority and the Grantee with respect to the subject matter hereof. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or other agreements whether written, verbal, or otherwise between the Grantee and the Authority that are in conflict with the provisions of this Agreement are hereby declared superseded and this Agreement shall control.

9.4. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this Agreement is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body, or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

9.5. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be deemed to be executed in the Village of Gilberts, State of Illinois, and shall be governed in all respects, including validity, interpretation and effect, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Illinois, as applicable to contracts entered into and performed entirely within the State, irrespective of conflict of laws principles. The parties consent to venue for any disputes arising under this Agreement being



in any state court serving Kane County or any federal court having jurisdiction thereof.

9.6. *Modification*

No provision of this Agreement shall be amended or otherwise modified, in whole or in part, except by an instrument, in writing, duly executed by the Authority and the Grantee, which amendment shall be authorized on behalf of the Authority through the adoption of an appropriate resolution or order by the Authority, as required by applicable law.

9.7. *No Third Party Beneficiaries*

Nothing in this Agreement or in any prior agreement is or was intended to confer third-party beneficiary status on any member of the public to enforce the terms of such Agreement.

9.8. *No Waiver of Rights*

Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as a waiver of any rights, substantive or procedural. Grantee may have under federal or state law unless such waiver is expressly stated herein.
